The full scale invasion of russia was followed by the enormous quantity of war crimes and war related crimes






The priority track of training activities is the peculiarities of pretrial investigations and public prosecutions of different types of war crimes and war-related crimes




"Professional ethics of the prosecutor"






FUTURE PLANS TO IMPLEMENT HELP TUTORS COURSES

- 10) International cooperation in criminal matters




