





 Free guided tour in archaeological sites and in the region of Paphos in different languages;


Artists, pottery, icon making, painting ateliers;

#### The idea is quite simple:


You can just drop by, chat with each other and at the same time polish up your language skills, make new friends and find out more about other cultures. The meeting will be led by native speakers.


