One puppet workshop. Participants watch a show and create their own puppets, tell their story. Plays or exhibition could be created at a later stage



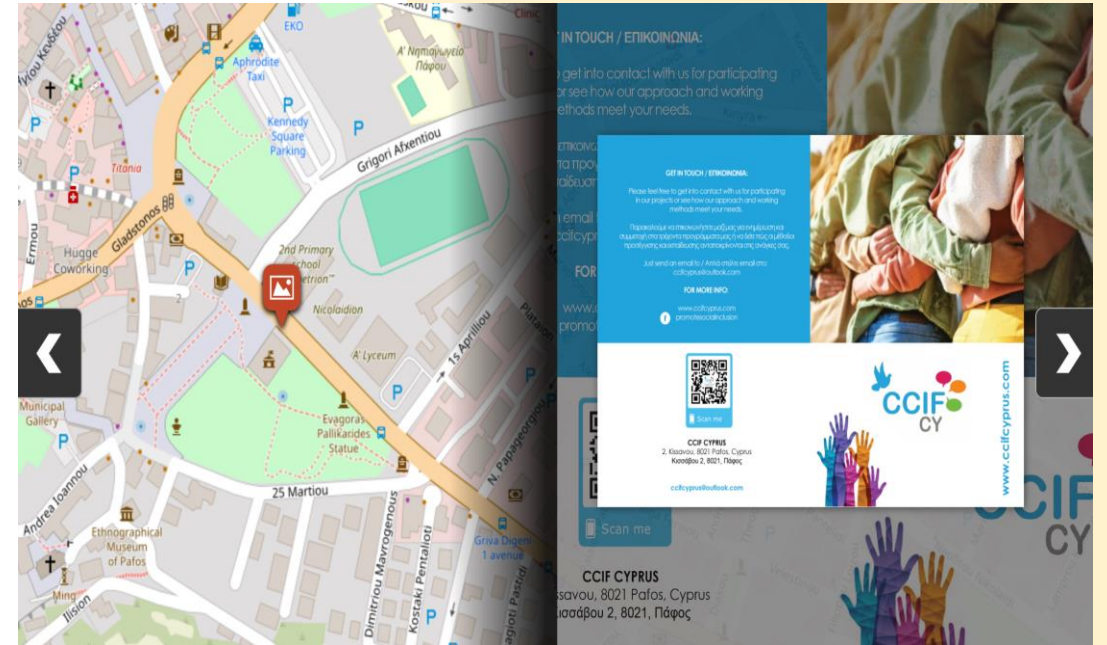
Welcoming statement:

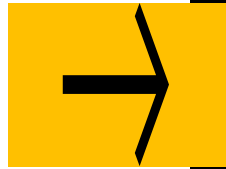
Online Intercultural Calendar:

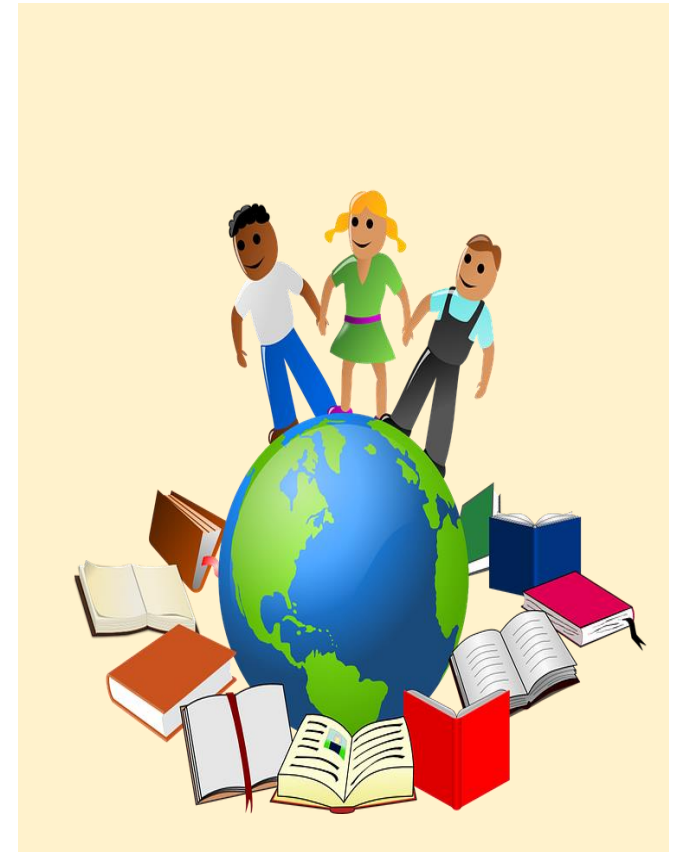
