Reaffirming that democracy is a fundamental feature of the European public order aimed at ensuring peaceful coexistence within our societies and between nations; underscoring also the inextricable link between democracy, human rights and the rule of law, as well as the importance of democracy as a cornerstone for member States in addressing current and future challenges to ensure security, stability and prosperity in Europe; and highlighting the crucial role of the Council of Europe in the current geopolitical context,

The Committee of Ministers

1. welcomed the Secretary General's "Road map towards a New Democratic Pact for Europe – Building a resilient, inclusive and agile democracy", as it appears in document SG/Inf(2025)14;
2. invited the Secretary General to implement the road map and to report back on progress at its next Ministerial Session.
