

- Prohibition of Ill-treatment Art. 3
- Right to liberty and security Art. 5
- Right to a fair trial Art. 6
- Right to respect for private and family life Art. 8
- Protection of property Art. 1 Protocol 1.

Integration of HELP courses in National Training Institutions

 35 HELP courses have been integrated as compulsory or optional parts of initial and continuous training by NTIs in 2023-2024

Best practices:

Bar Associations

 Albania and North Macedonia: HELP Child Friendly Justice is compulsory for legal professionals working with children

Judicial Academies

- Serbia: 4 HELP courses are compulsory in the initial training + 2 optional
- BiH: 2 HELP courses are compulsory





Synergies and cooperation with HF actions and other CoE projects

- Support with translation, upload and implementation
- 29 HELP courses during 2023-2024 implemented
- in cooperation with 14 joint EU/CoE actions and VC projects
- across five Beneficiaries
