- · Biweekly "1-2-1" mental health Supervision Coordinators
- Biweekly Group Therapy Coordinators
- 54 nationalities or bi-nationals

V-Europe: who are we? (IV)



=> Goal:

On the field support of all recognised VoT, without any discrimination, to allow them to rebuild themselves as good as possible and to reintegrate society as a proud citizen

=> Pillars to reach goal:

DIGNITY - MEMORY - TRUTH - JUSTICE



TRUTH (I)

V-EUROPE

- => The need to understand what we are a victim from
- => ISIS (Da'esh): Who are they? Why did they killed my family and/or tried to kill me?
- => From 2018 until 2022:

V-Europe goes "on the field" to understand the source of perpetrators:

- Iraq (KRG / Mossul)
- North East Syria (Rojava)



TRUTH (II)



=> Rojava

- FTF (prisons)
- · ISIS (Da'esh) women & children
 - · Al Roj / Al Hol
- · Victims of ISIS (Da'esh)

=> Iraq

- Victims of ISIS (Da'esh)
 - · Muslims, Yezidi, Christians from the Orient
 - · Kurdistan, Mosul, Sinjar

JUSTICE (I)



- => Justice is not Revenge.... but a need of recognition for the VoT
- => V-Europe's participation at Prosecution
- Shooting Driesstraat, Belgium (Police Forces => Abdeslam / Ayari)
- Jewish Museum Belgium (1st ISIS attack on EU soil) (Partnering AfVT & CAT)
- Bamako Hotel attack, Mali (direct support VoT)
- Sousse, Tunis (direct support VoT)
- Barcelona, Spain (direct support VoT)

JUSTICE (II)



- Paris 13/11 attacks, France (Partnering AfVT, 13onze15)
- · Brussels 22/3 attacks, Belgium
 - www.22-3.be => became the reference website for VoT, authorities, press, society
 - agenda
 - debriefings
- => Yezidi Genocide recognition (Belgium Gov't)
- V-Europe missions (MP's participation)
- Participation Foreign Terrorist Activities VS Crimes against Humanity

ISIS Soldiers (FTF) (I)



Reflections on experiences:

- "Innocence" claims
- "No regrets"
- Not realising / not willing to realise the ISIS atrocities
 VS
 accusing ISIS by "disconnecting" themselves from it?
 - psychological surviving mode?
 - Taqiyya: the right to lie and/or commit a sinful action to defend the religious cause

ISIS Soldiers (FTF) (II)



Justice & Prosecution

- AANES
 - Requires prosecution following International and Human Rights laws
 - No "death sentence" (for FTF)
- Re geopolitical situations: no current way out

ISIS Soldiers (FTF) (III)



The Future?

- Local prosecution (what about imprisonment after eventual trial?)
 VS
 home country prosecution (what about international cooperation?)
- Escape risks? (cfr 2022 Hassaka attack)
- Long term imprisonment under current conditions not very likely
 (Baghouz 2019...=> 5 years and counting...)

ISIS Women & children (I)



Meetings with women and children in the Kurdish detention camps in NE Syria

- Foreign nationals
- Al Roj VS Al Hol
- Meeting constraints:
 - Time slots
 - Finding the women in the camps (Al Hol)

ISIS Women & children (II)



Reflections on experiences:

- Change of attitude over the years (2018 -> 2022)
- "Innocence"
- ISIS support VS willingness to exfiltrate
 - Children (language, games, etc.)
 - Risk of life (revenge, burning tents, etc.)
- Estimation of "illegal detention"
 - "Hypocrisy" of home country => increase/support of extremism

ISIS Women & children (III) V-EVROPE



Justice & Prosecution

- No prosecution in Rojava
- Returnees
 - Variable per country of residence (e.g. Belgium, France, Germany, The Netherlands)

The Future?

- Non returnees:
 - Costs camps / ISIS build up in region and camps
 - Women are seen by ISIS as key for their future (bearing children)

Some Risks....? (I)



- There is no good solution: we must find the least bad solution
- Time is against us
 - Dragging on with a "temporary situation" without a real solution
 => increase of feeling of "injustice"
 - => supporting their extremism (Caliphate vision) and build up of hate
 - ISIS build up (region, prisons, camps)
 - 5 to 12 years living in extremism with a most barbaric history
 - > psychological impact / disconnected from any other way of live and society
- Geopolitical impasse

Some Risks....? (II)



- Risk of "revenge"
 - ISIS soldiers
 - Women
 - Women are not always as innocent as we would like to believe..
 - Children
 - what did they do to my father and mother..?
 - living conditions of the first years of life.... (psychological impact)
 - ISIS (direct/indirect) preparation of some children to fight for the Caliphate....

Some Risks....? (III)



Reality seldom aligns with our desires

"We must uphold justice and adhere strictly to our democratic beliefs and values, but we must not naively ignore potential hidden dangers."

Victims of Terrorism (I)



Our societal obligations:

- supporting VoT in rebuilding themselves
 - e.g; V-Europe's Coordinators program
- connecting VoT to society (and vice versa)
 - e..g Together Stronger activities
 - www.togetherstronger.eu
- build a positive meaning to the atrocities VoT went through
 - P/CVE is a complex matter, touch-basing various fields. Voices of VoT can provide a tremendous support in P/CVE activities
 - e.g. Schools and prison

Victims of Terrorism (II)



Key:

- => providing the needed support to the victims of terrorism, so that they can rebuild themselves as good as possible
- => reintegrating the victims into our society
- => connecting the VoT to the projects Returnees' integration

Cooperation and coordination among all stakeholders, including the victims, increases chances of success for all parties.

By doing this, we realise a main step in countering terrorism:

Terrorism will not fragment our society, but at the contrary it will strengthen us.
