**2.2.B** - The law obliges that the finds recovered from an archaeological work, and its documentation, will be incorporated on a Museum after a maximum deadline of two years after the work is completed. Until then, finds and its documentation are usually kept together with the trusteeship. The DGPC, the state institution with legal responsibilities for the heritage, obliges the archaeologist to hand in the reports from archaeological work, becoming also the detainer of such documentation, but without the remains or finds.

Archaeological heritage – the records of archaeological finds are reported to the competent authorities by the finders, whoever might be. Then the records of archaeological heritage is exclusively made by professionals with qualifications, that have the permits granted by the DGPC to act according the law. For the underwater archaeological finds, the system used is different, once the report of the finds is made to the competent authorities the record is exclusively made by state technicians, working on the DGPC. Finally, all the data is registered in the DGPC database - Endovélico.
