Archaeological heritage – The preventive archaeological work has public funding only in the public building and infrastructure projects, such as dams, electricity network, road and train network, etc.

On the last few years, different central administration departments were joined together into the General Directorate for the Cultural Heritage. Therefore, the financial data available only concern the year 2012, where the total 3.285.694€ budget for immovable heritage (archaeological, architectural and landscape) was divided on 6 items:

- Preservation - 3.103.753€
- Conservation and restoration - 103.307€
- Conservation and maintenance - 4.613€
- National Plan of Archaeology Conservation (PNTA) - 17.803€
- Archaeology publications - 34.915€
- Other publications - 21.303€
