Main Principles

- ✓ **Entirely based on Art. 17 and Art. 12 Reporting Tools**
- ✓ **For the Res. 8 Reporting Format, all specific items related to birds are merged into one tool, with Art. 17 tool as the basis**
- ✓ **Based on MSAccess development tool**
- ✓ **The Database Structure of Art. 17 is amended accordingly (to include a few new fields and to merged tables and fields related to Birds)**
- ✓ **All look-up tables are amended towards Res. 8 (country list, species and habitat checklists etc ...)**
- ✓ **The tool contains an export module towards xml-format, preparing the data to be uploaded to the CDR**

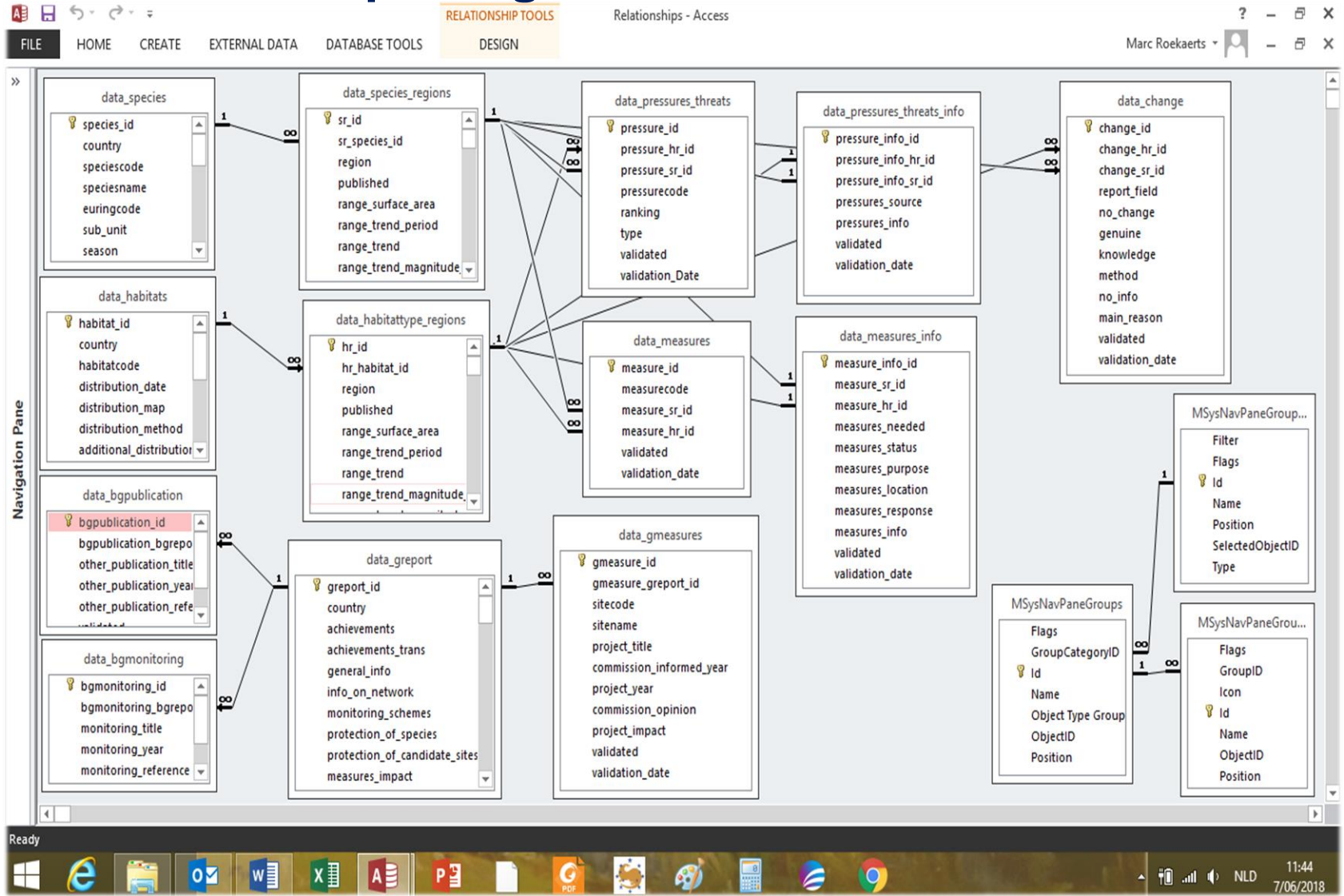
