


Main Principles

- ✓ Entirely based on Art. 17 and Art. 12 Reporting Tools
- ✓ But as for the Res. No. 8 (2012) Reporting Format, all specific items related to birds are merged into one tool, with Art. 17 tool as the basis
- √ Based on MSAccess development tool
- ✓ The Database Structure of Art. 17 is amended accordingly.
- ✓ All look-up tables amended towards Res. No. 8 (2012) (country list, species and habitat lists etc ...)
- ✓ The tool contains an export module towards xml-format, preparing the data to be uploaded to the CDR









Res. No. 8 (2012) Reporting Format Database Structure



2018 Test phase

- ✓ Report for 1 Habitat, 1 Bird and 1 other species is expected
- ✓ Data entry using Excel sheets, corresponding to the Reporting Format
- ✓ Data will be transformed into the format as used in the Res. No. 8 (2012) Tool
- ✓ These data will serve as test data for the Tool under development
- ✓ The data will be available in Res. No. 8 (2012) data format for the
 2019 reporting obligations (no duplicated data entry)
