TRAVEL

Arriving in Paris

Paris is a major international hub and can be reached via multiple transport options:

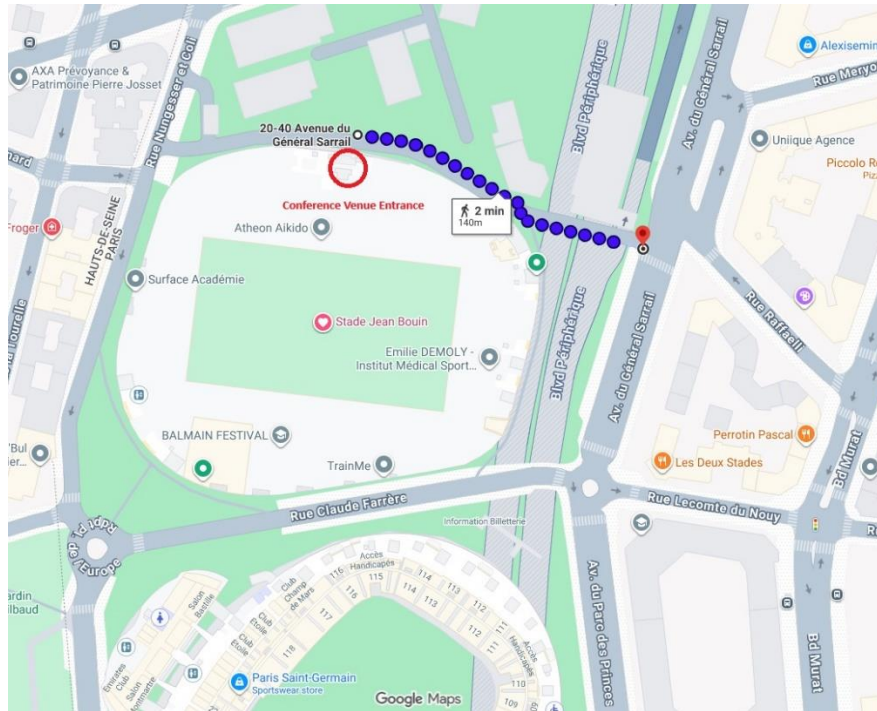
- **By air:** International flights arrive at Charles de Gaulle Airport and Orly Airport
- **By train:** High-speed rail services (TGV, Eurostar, Thalys) connect Paris to major European cities via stations such as Gare du Nord, Gare de Lyon, and Gare Montparnasse
- **By car:** Paris is accessible via an extensive motorway network
- **By bus:** Long-distance coach services operate from many European destinations

Reaching the Conference Venue

The conference will take place at:

Stade Jean Bouin

Stade Jean Bouin, 20-40 Av. du Général Sarrail, 75016 Paris, France



Located in the 16th arrondissement of Paris, the venue is well served by public transport:

Metro

- **Line 9** → *Porte de Saint-Cloud* (approx. 10-minute walk)
- **Line 10** → *Porte d'Auteuil* (approx. 15-minute walk)

Tram

- **Tramway T3a** → *Porte de Saint-Cloud* (very close to the venue)

Bus

Several bus lines stop nearby, including:

- Lines 22, 62, 72, 123, 189, and 289

Taxi / Ride-hailing

- Taxis and services like Uber are widely available throughout the city

Additional Tips

- Public transport in Paris is operated by RATP

- Allow extra travel time during peak hours (08:00–10:00 and 17:00–19:00)

WEATHER INFORMATION

Paris typically experiences **late-spring conditions** at the end of May:



Typical Conditions

- **Average daytime temperature:** ~20–22°C
- **Night temperature:** ~10–13°C
- **General pattern:** Mild, often sunny, but variable
- **Rain:** Occasional showers are common in late May
