

Please kindly note that this year, the Standing Committee will meet in AGORA BUILDING (facing the Human Rights Building) in Room G3 (and Room G4 for the EU coordination meetings) and not in the Palais de l'Europe building as previous years.

ACCESS TO AND EXIT FROM THE AGORA BUILDING

At your arrival in front of the building, you first have to pass the turnstile (no badge needed for this). You will receive your access badge at the main entrance when entering the Agora building upon presentation of your personal invitation letter and your passport/identity card.

For security measures, the Agora building main entrance closes at 7:00pm. If you wish to leave Agora after 7:00pm, you will have to go out by the back of the building on ground 0 (see above).

HOW TO GET TO AGORA BUILDING

 By tram	Tram E direction Baggersee/Robertsau Boecklin Get off at Droits de l'Homme (10 trams/hour)
 By bus	Bus 6 direction Pont Phario or Hoenheim Get off at Palais des Droits de l'Homme (7 buses/hour) Bus 30 direction Wattwiller or Robertsau Get off at Palais des Droits de l'Homme (6 buses/hour) Bus 72 direction République or La Wantzenau (1 bus/hour) Get off at Palais des Droits de l'Homme
 By taxi	There is a taxi rank by the main entrance to the Palais de l'Europe.

LUNCHES

There is no restaurant in Agora building, but a Cafeteria on ground 2 floor (near the main entrance). It provides fresh sandwiches and paninis, a salad bar, warm daily soup, drinks and other snacks. A “takeaway dining area” is available on the 0 level (just near the G3 meeting room).

If you prefer a complete lunch, your security access badge allows you to enter the Palais de l'Europe and reach the Restaurant Bleu or the self-service canteen. There are also a few restaurants close to the Agora building, but please consider booking a table:
