- ❖ Travellers from Dublin to Cork using the bus, the bus stop is 7minutes by walk from the Clayton Hotel Cork.

- ❖ Travellers from Cork Airport: the Hotel is 12minutes way by taxi (cost estimation 20€). Buses from the Airport to the city center are also available Bus Éireann 226 and 226A.
