Venue

The event will take place in two locations in Strasbourg:

 Palais de l'Europe

Council of Europe
Avenue de l'Europe
67000 Strasbourg, France

 European Youth Centre Strasbourg (EYCS)

30 rue Pierre de Coubertin
67000 Strasbourg, France

Both venues are located in the European institutions district and are within **10–15 minutes walking distance** from each other.

How to Reach Strasbourg

 By plane

- **Strasbourg Airport (SXB)** – approx. 20 minutes from the city centre by train or taxi
- **EuroAirport Basel–Mulhouse–Freiburg** – approx. 1h30 by shuttle + train
- **Frankfurt Airport** – approx. 2 hours by train

 By train

Strasbourg is well connected by high-speed rail:

- Paris → Strasbourg: approx. 1h45
- Frankfurt → Strasbourg: approx. 2h
- Stuttgart → Strasbourg: approx. 1h30

Arrival station: **Strasbourg Central Station (Gare de Strasbourg)**





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From Strasbourg Station to the Venues



By tram

Take **Tram Line E** (direction Robertsau Boecklin)

- Stop: “**Droits de l’Homme**” for the Palais de l’Europe
- Stop: “**Parlement Européen**” or “**Wacken**” for the Youth Centre

Travel time: approx. **15 minutes**



By taxi / ride-hailing

Travel time: approx. **10–15 minutes** from the station.

Accommodation

Selected participants will be accommodated at the **European Youth Centre Strasbourg**, where most workshop activities will also take place.

Rooms are simple and functional, in line with the Centre’s educational environment.

Meals

- Coffee breaks and lunches will be provided during the event.
- A reception hosted under the Monaco Presidency will take place on Day 1.

Visa Support
