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1. INTRODUCTION

The Advisory Forum is the most important annual gathering of the Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe programme. It brings together representatives of the Enlarged Partial Agreement on Cultural Routes (EPA), certified and candidate Cultural Routes, international organisations, cultural institutions, universities, tourism stakeholders, policymakers, researchers and heritage professionals.

The 15th Advisory Forum will take place in Yerevan, Armenia, from 23 to 25 September 2026 under the theme: **Routes Through Time and Cultures - Educating for Sustainable Heritage.**

Yerevan, one of the world's oldest continuously inhabited cities, provides a unique setting for the Forum. Combining a rich historical heritage with a vibrant contemporary cultural scene, Armenia's capital offers participants an exceptional opportunity to experience education through culture and heritage.

2. FORUM VENUE

DoubleTree by Hilton Yerevan

The 15th Advisory Forum on Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe will take place at DoubleTree by Hilton Yerevan.

The hotel offers modern conference facilities, meeting rooms, exhibition spaces and hospitality services suitable for large-scale international events.

The venue is conveniently located near the city centre and within easy reach of Yerevan's principal cultural institutions.

3. VISA REQUIREMENTS

Participants are responsible for verifying visa requirements applicable to their nationality before travelling to Armenia. Citizens of many countries may enter Armenia without a visa. Others may apply through Armenia's electronic visa (e-Visa) system.

Participants requiring visas are strongly encouraged to begin the application process well in advance of their travel dates. Official invitation letters supporting visa applications can be issued by the Forum Secretariat following successful registration. For updated information on visa requirements and application procedures, participants should consult the official e-Visa portal of the Republic of Armenia.



4. CURRENCY

The official currency of Armenia is the Armenian Dram (AMD). Currency exchange services are widely available at the airport, banks, exchange offices and major hotels. International credit and debit cards are accepted in most hotels, restaurants, shops and cultural institutions. ATMs are readily available throughout Yerevan.

5. TRAVEL TO ARMENIA

BY PLANE

The nearest international airport is **Zvartnots International Airport (EVN)**, Armenia's principal international gateway.

Located approximately 12 kilometres from the centre of Yerevan, the airport serves numerous destinations throughout Europe, the Middle East and Asia. Travel time between the airport and central Yerevan is approximately 20–30 minutes. Approximate taxi fare from the airport to central Yerevan ranges from 3,500 to 6,000 AMD (7-12 Euro)depending on destination and traffic conditions.

10. CULTURAL PROGRAMME VENUES

MATENADARAN

The Mesrop Mashtots Institute of Ancient Manuscripts, known as Matenadaran, houses one of the world's richest collections of medieval manuscripts and historical documents. The institution preserves thousands of manuscripts, miniature paintings, maps and archival materials representing centuries of Armenian intellectual and cultural history. Today Matenadaran serves both as a leading research centre and one of Armenia's most visited cultural institutions.

HISTORY MUSEUM OF ARMENIA

Founded in 1919, the History Museum of Armenia presents the story of Armenian civilisation from prehistoric times to the modern era. Its extensive collections include archaeological finds, ethnographic materials, coins, manuscripts and artefacts illustrating the development of Armenian culture across millennia.

NATIONAL GALLERY OF ARMENIA

The National Gallery of Armenia is the country's largest art museum and one of the most important collections in the South Caucasus. The museum houses Armenian, European and Russian masterpieces spanning several centuries and provides a comprehensive overview of regional artistic traditions.

GARNI TEMPLE

Built during the first century AD, Garni Temple is the only surviving Greco-Roman colonnaded temple in the region. Situated above the dramatic Azat River Gorge, Garni represents a unique synthesis of Armenian and classical traditions. Visitors may also admire the nearby basalt formations known as the "Symphony of Stones."



GEGHARD MONASTERY

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Geghard Monastery is one of Armenia's most remarkable examples of medieval religious architecture. Partially carved into the surrounding cliffs, the monastery demonstrates extraordinary craftsmanship and remains an active pilgrimage destination.

ZVARTNOTS CATHEDRAL

Constructed in the seventh century, Zvartnots Cathedral is a masterpiece of early medieval Armenian architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Although preserved today as archaeological ruins, its innovative design influenced architectural developments throughout the region. The Gala Dinner and Closing Reception of the Forum will be held at this exceptional heritage site.
