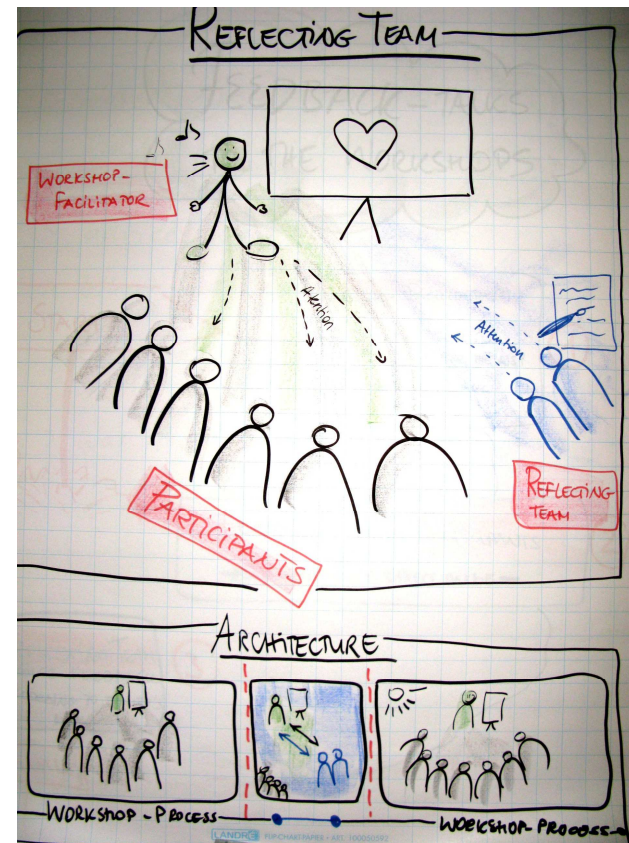
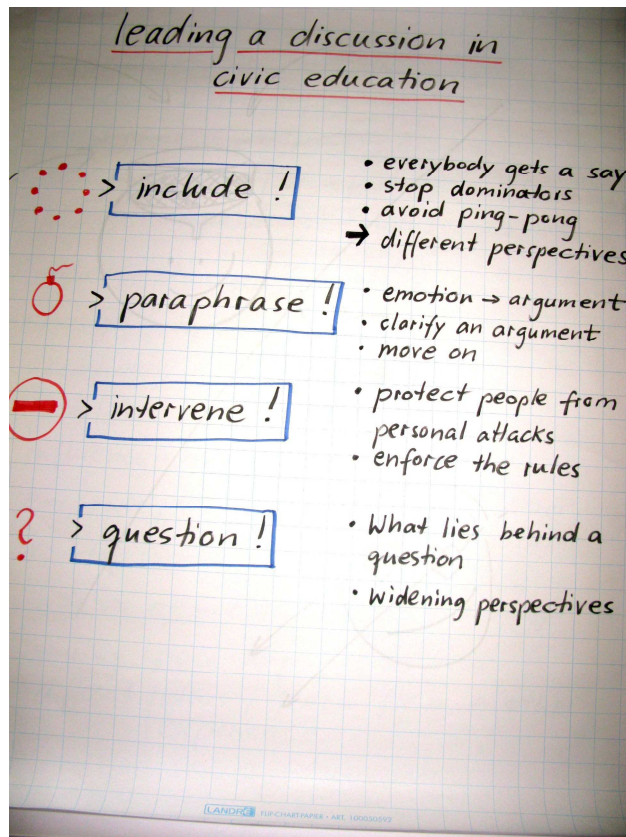
Module 2

- Didactic plan / content / method; Development of workshops; Feedback

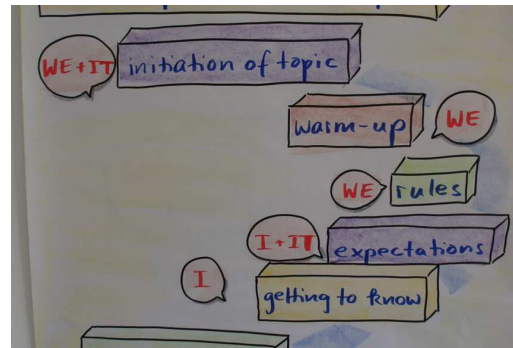


Module 4: Excursion to Berlin

Introduction to „theme centered interaction (TCI), didactic structure of an educational program, methods training, position and function of a seminar facilitator / trainer

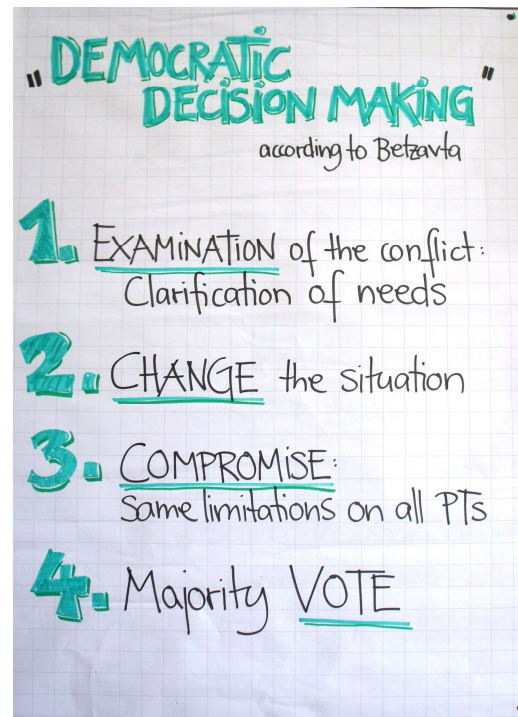
Module 6: Excursion to Buchenwald Memorial

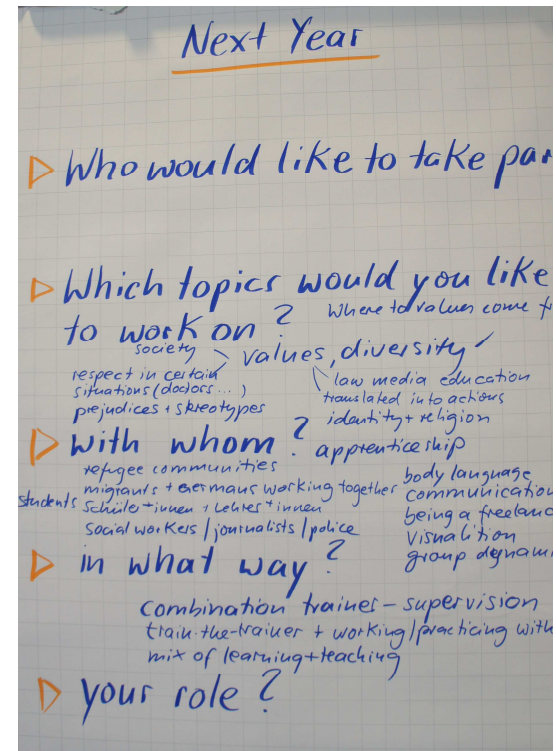
