- With increasing access to the internet and ICT technologies, gender-based violence against women is no longer restricted to real-world forms of violence: there is an ever-growing digital dimension of this violation of women's human rights. Perpetrators now use technology to control or spy on the victims, blackmail them, disseminate their intimate pictures or videos, steal their identity and send them threatening or insulting messages.
- The phenomenon of online and technology-facilitated violence against women is complex and far-reaching. Bringing together representatives from the EDVAW Platform, international organisations, parliamentarians and civil society on the panel, this high-level side event will present initiatives and strategies to address online and technology facilitated violence against women on the basis of existing international legal instruments. It will draw upon promising research, policies and initiatives from across the world.
