## New Council of Europe e-learning course on safety, security and service at sports events

- The Council of Europe e-learning course on safety, security and service at sports events is a product of the Council of Europe and the European Union joint project: "Promoting and Strengthening the Council of Europe standards on safety, security and service at football matches and other sports events" (PROS4+).
- The course aims to promote the standards enshrined in the 2016 "Council of Europe Convention on an Integrated Safety, Security and Service Approach at Football Matches and Other Sports Events" (Saint-Denis Convention) and the Standing Committee Recommendation Rec (2015)1.
- It is comprised of eight modules, which contain elements to lead effective and efficient safety, security and service management at sports events with the ultimate aim of making football matches and other sports events more welcoming, safe and secure. The course primarily intends to serve public officials and practitioners in the fields of safety, security and service. Nevertheless, it can also be useful for other professionals such as legal professionals and health workers. At the end of the eight modules and having passed all the intermediate tests, the candidate will receive a certification.
- The Council of Europe collaborated with the University of Liverpool, Centre for Educational Development and Support (CEDS) for the development of this course. This unique course was launched during the 47th meeting of the Standing Committee of the European Convention on Spectator Violence in Strasbourg in December 2018.
