- The World Café methodology aims to create a welcoming environment conducive to the exchange of multiple ideas and perspectives on various topics by involving participants in several rounds of small-group conversations.
- In today's World Café, we will explore burning issues from Day 1 related to advocacy against violence against women and domestic violence and to the promotion of gender equality. Through our conversations, we aim to listen, learn, and collaborate with each other to explore new possibilities for our work.

Concluding the World Café

In plenary, the hosts will share the key discussions and ideas from each table with the entire group. Collectively we will agree on the final document – a Call to Action that we will endeavour to commit to for our future work.

How to Participate

1. Choose a table

Participants will address burning issues from Day 1 at 10 different tables. There is a maximum number of people per table, so if the table is full, please choose another one.

2. Have a conversation

➤ To ensure continuity of ideas, each group is introduced to the previous discussion at their new table by a designated "table host". Please listen to your host, share openly, and be respectful of the other members of your group. Collectively record your ideas on the provided paper.

3. Move to the next table

Please move to another table when you are asked, so as not to cause delays. Table rotation occurs every 20 minutes.

4. Discussions over coffee

➤ You are welcome to enjoy coffee during discussions, which will be available throughout the event.
