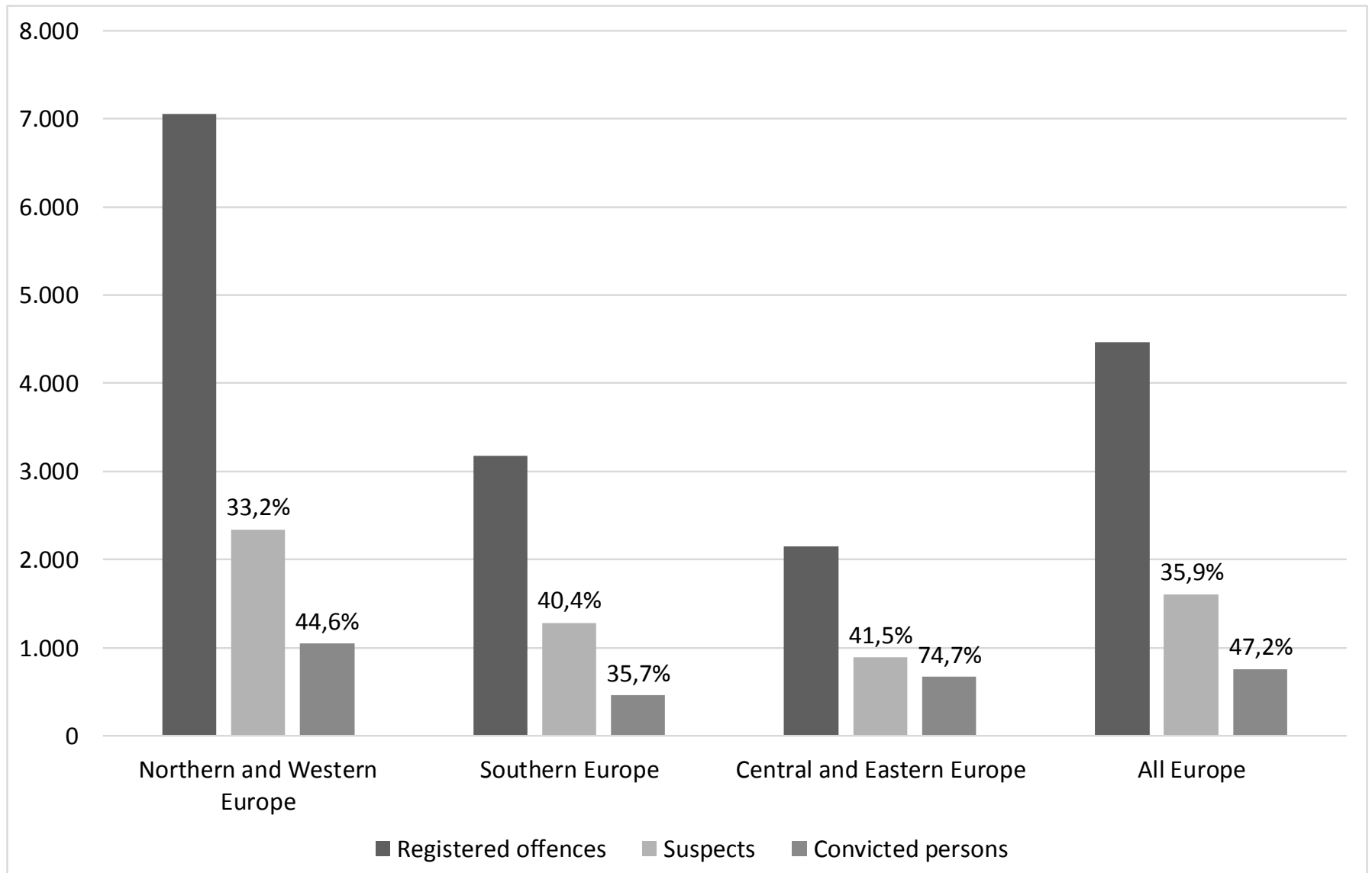

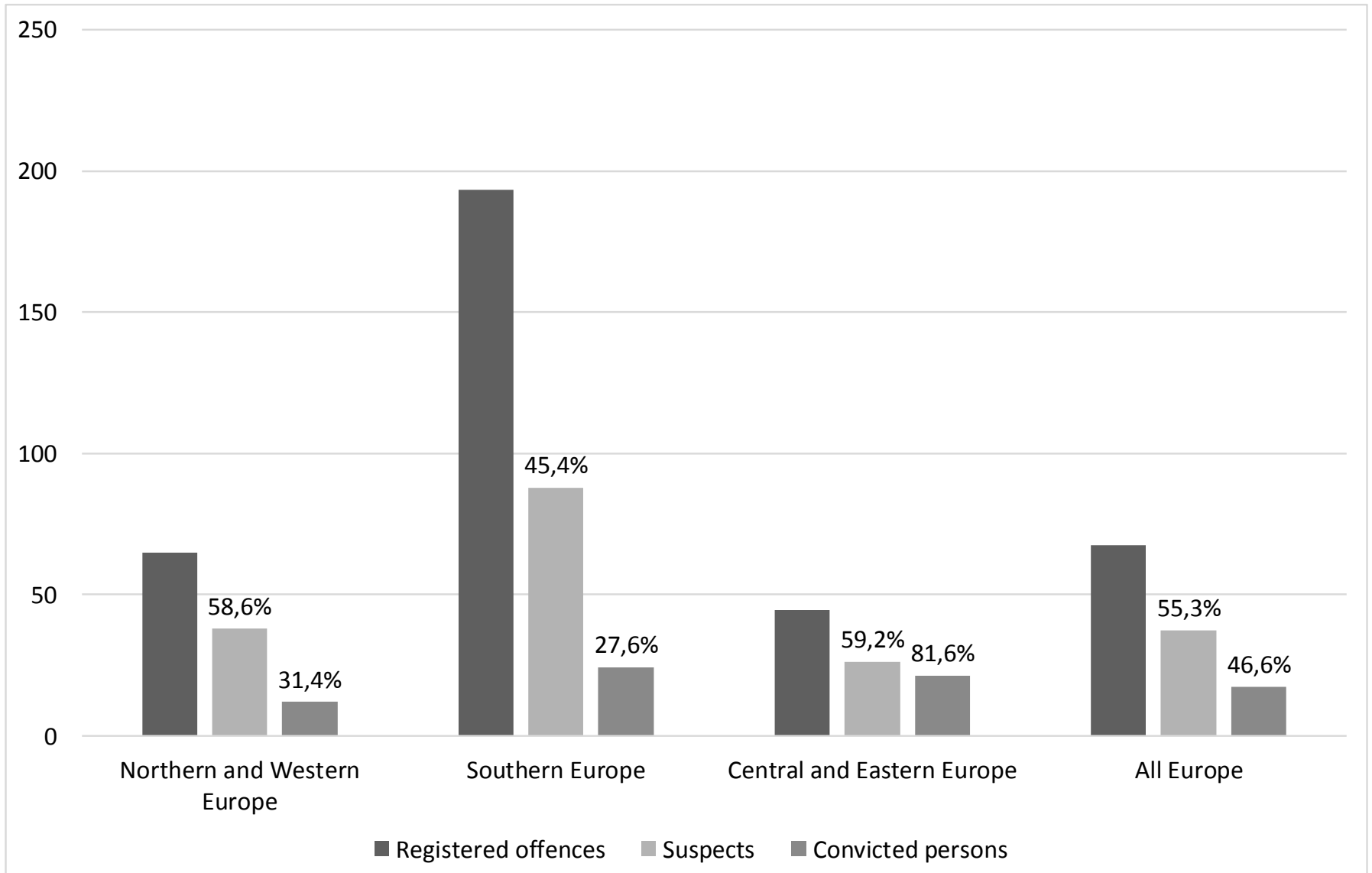
Attrition processes for criminal offences total in 2010 (rates per 100,000 population)

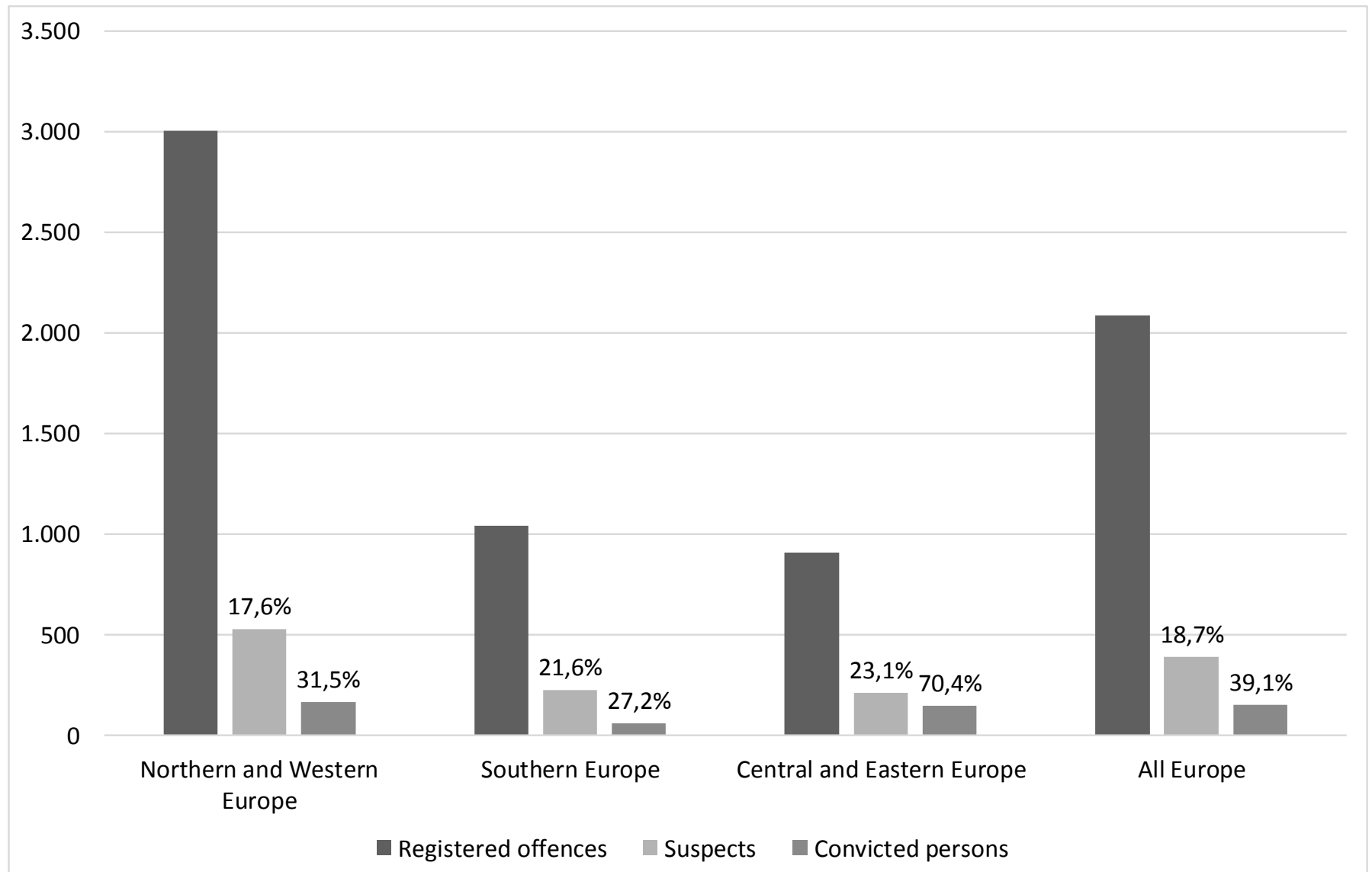
Attrition processes for robbery in 2010 (rates per 100,000 population)

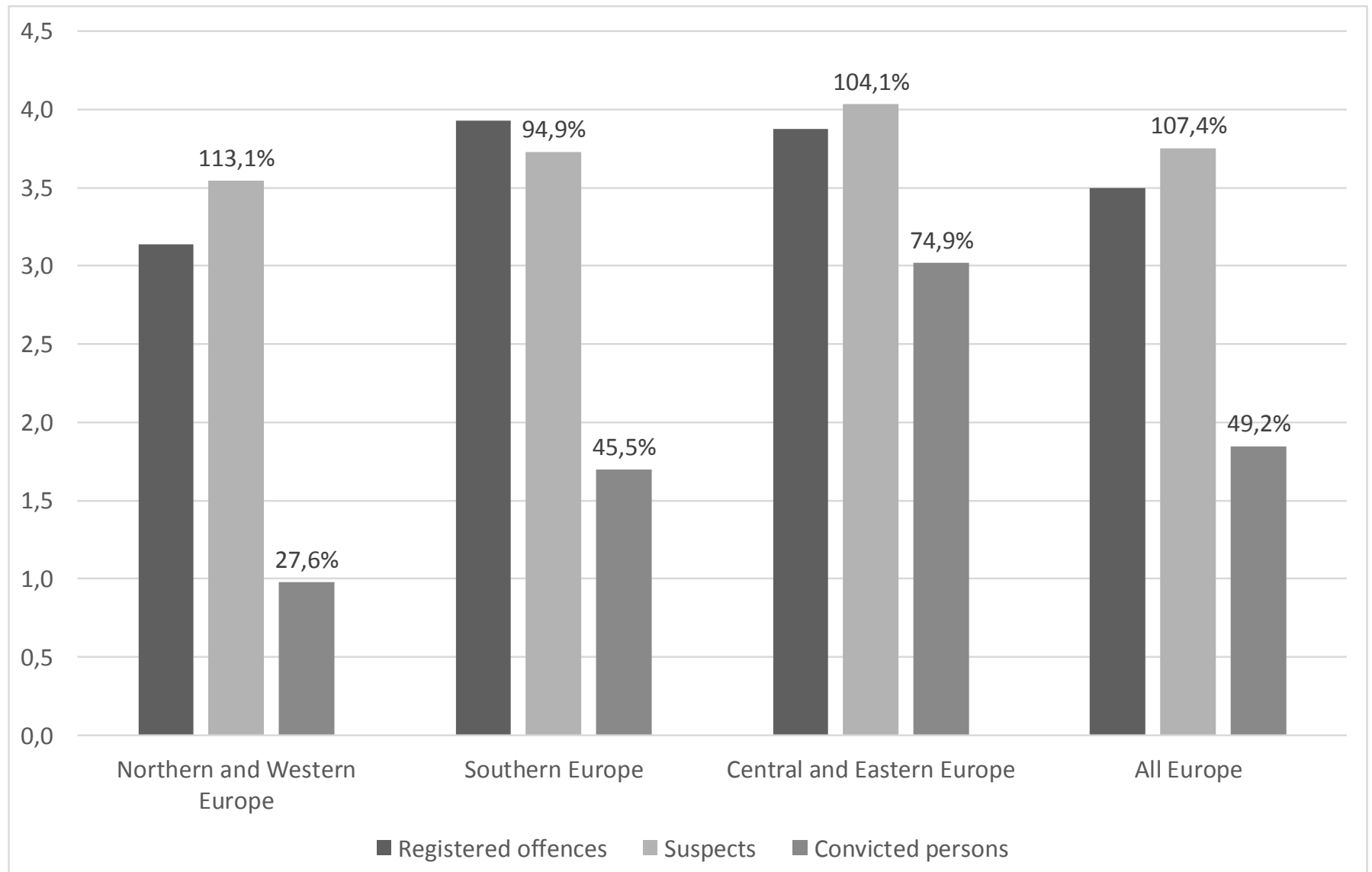
Attrition processes for theft in 2010 (rates per 100,000 population)

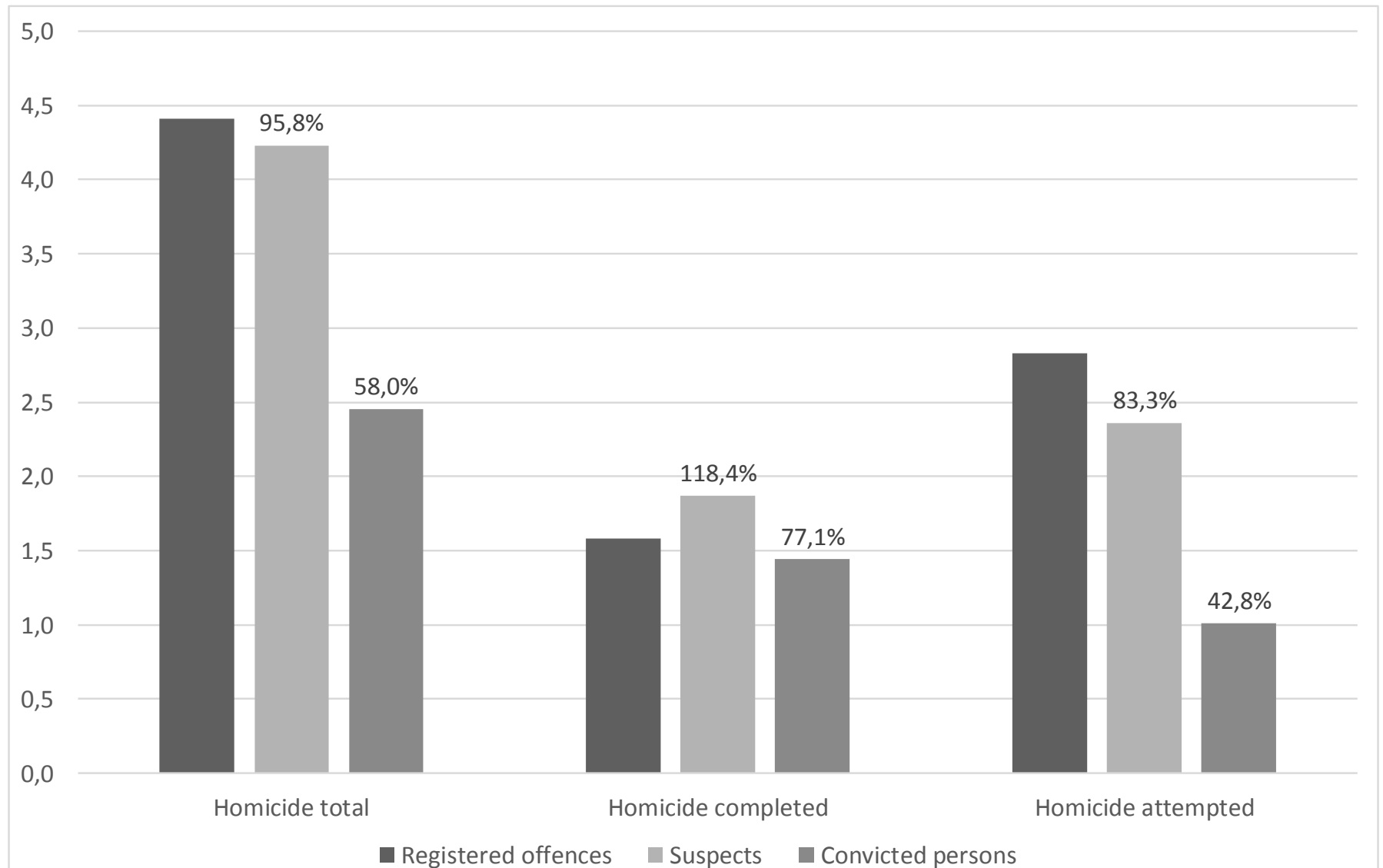
Attrition processes for intentional homicide in 2010 (rates per 100,000 population)

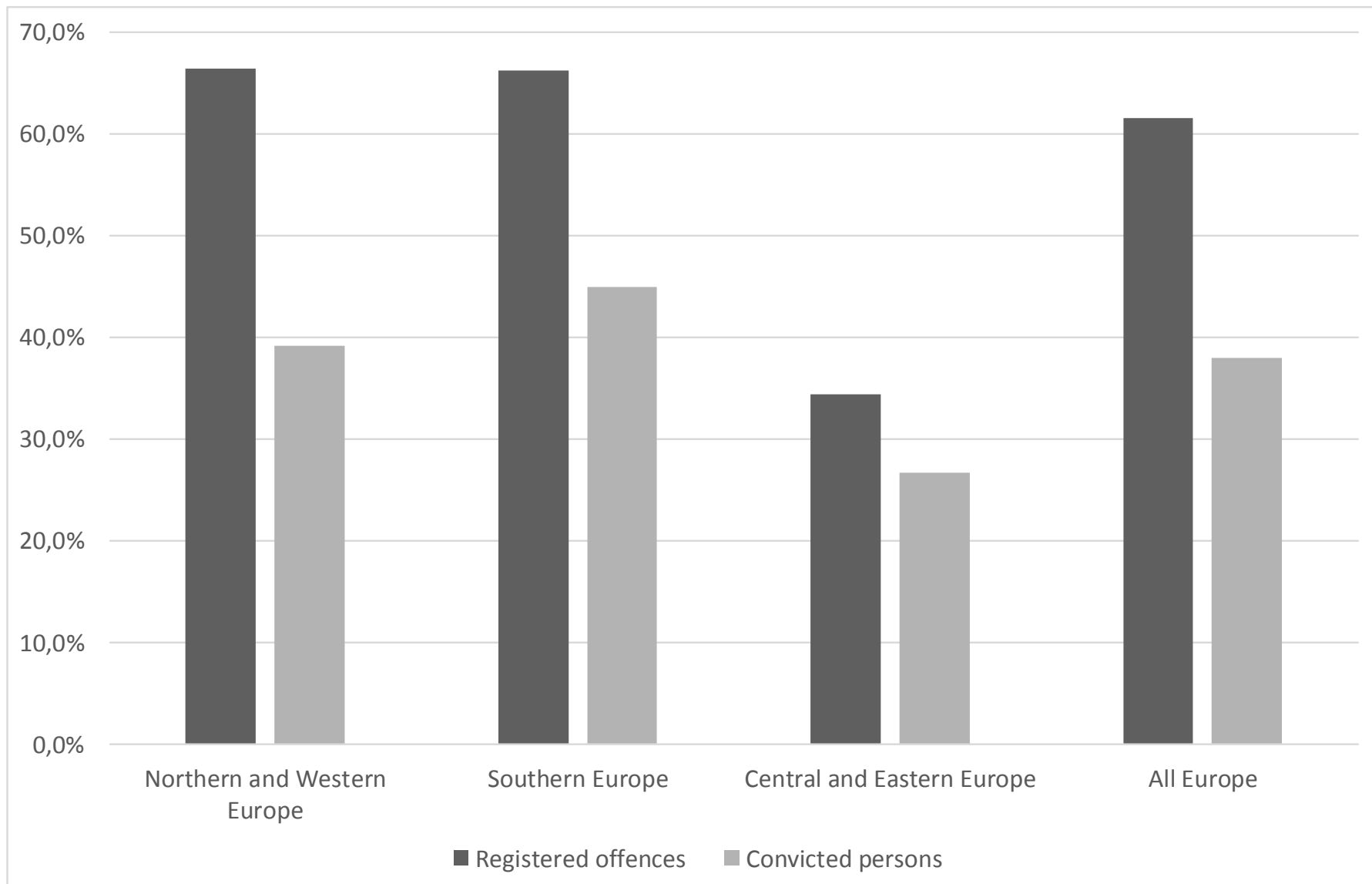
Attrition processes for completed and attempted intentional homicide in 2010 compared (rates per 100,000 population)

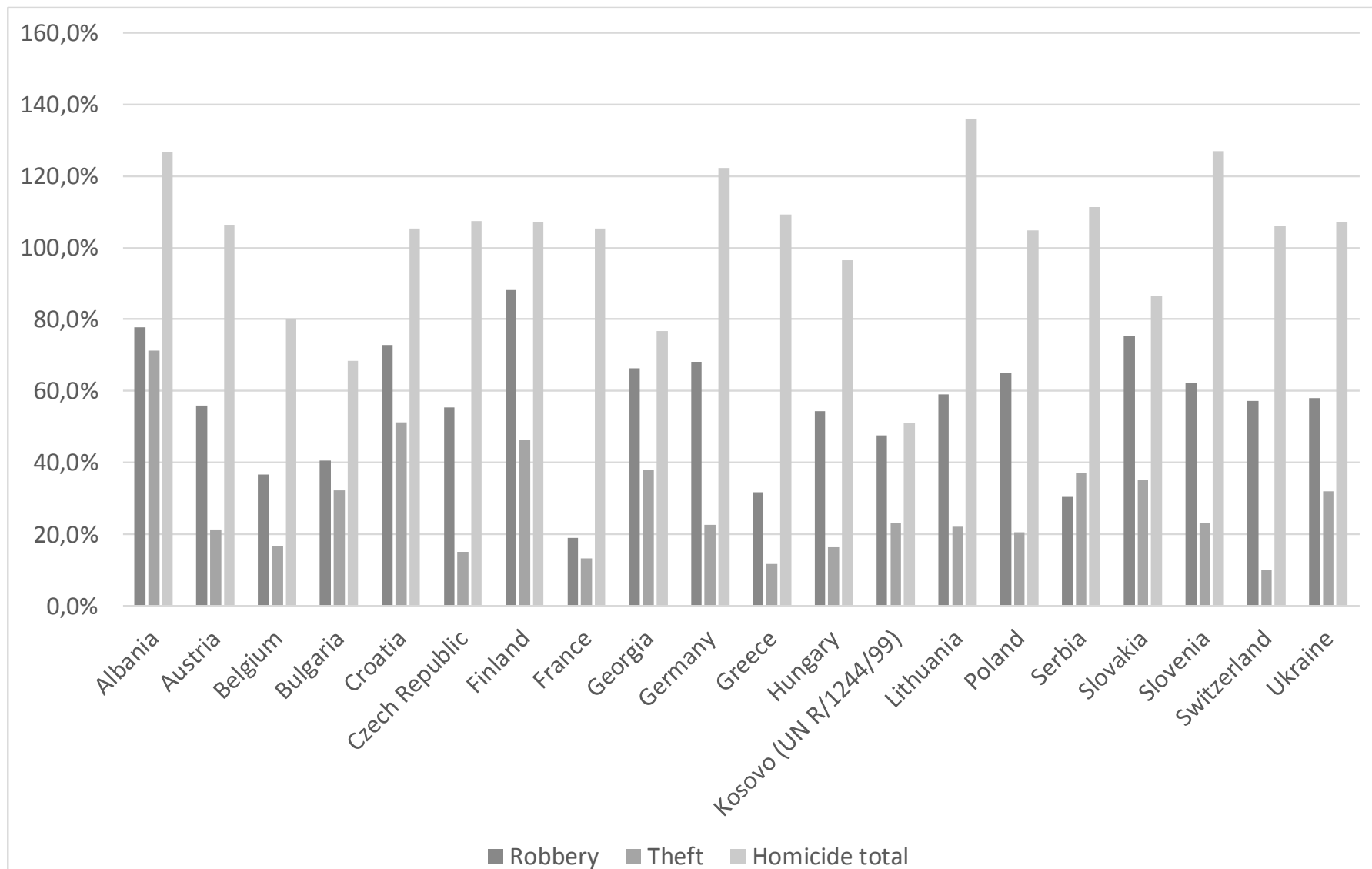
Attempt ratios for intentional homicide in 2010
