10 March 2021	- Third consultation webinar on the ESC
Drafting Group (EPAS GB) May 2021	<ul> <li>Discussion on amendments</li> <li>Approval of Draft 3</li> </ul>
May 2021	<ul> <li>Possible additional consultations</li> <li>Consultation of non EPAS MS</li> </ul>
Governing Board June 2021	Final approval

### Draft 2

- 20 articles
- Preamble re-structured and split into citations and recitals
- ESC text was updated and consistency of the terms was improved
- New elements were added:
  - Reference to good governance (article 3 public authorities and article 4 sports movement)
  - Corporate and professional sector (article 5)
  - Human Rights (article 6)
  - Promotion of physical and organisational integrity (article 8)
  - Promotion of sustainability (article 9)
  - Right to sport (article 10)
  - Support and follow-up to the implementation of the Charter





### Draft 2

- Open issues to be further disc used
  - European Sports Model
  - Implementation and monitoring framework
