Awareness

For us, this can be achieved via:

- info-days and events (how original!!)
- production of specific promotional material
- interactive activities (or enhancing already existing ones) connecting CRs with local society

Information

about funding mechanisms on pan-European level e.g.:

- Routes4U program
- European Regional Development Fund (ERDF)
- INTERREG / ADRION
- Creative Europe program
- Cosme (routes+ entrepreneurship)
- Horizon 2020 (routes + innovation, and new technologies)

Synergies and Networking (It's some Greek [Stakeholders] to me)

- The case of the Olive Tree Routes, and
- The case of the European Cemeteries Routes

Some of the common actions we follow in both cases:

- Establishing a link between CRs and State Institutions as well as entities dealing with all relative aspects of Cultural Heritage
- Implementation of specifically designed educational programs
- Introducing stakeholders to entities dealing with the economic aspect of local/regional life
