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The main tasks at the start of the decentralization reform




- Approval of a new territorial basis for the operation of the administrative bodies at the local and regional level
- Transfer (decentralization) of the executive powers to local selfgovernment bodies and distribution of these powers between the central and subnational levels according to the principle of subsidiarity
- Establishing an appropriate resource base to enable local self-government bodies to execute their powers
- Build-up of an effective system of service at local self-government bodies and bodies of executive power
- Development of the forms of direct democracy: elections, referenda
- Streamlining the system of administrative supervision on the legal operations of local government bodies
- New state regional policy for Ukraine






Formation of amalgamated communities in 2015-2019

As of **December 2019** in Ukraine were created **1008 amalgamated communities**



The dynamics of amalgamation



2019 – **1008** communities were created by voluntary amalgamation of 4572 territorial communities (41,7%)

6389 communities are still in the way (58,3%)




Budget decentralisation





Main tasks 2020




- Amendments to the Constitution of Ukraine (regarding decentralisation reform)
