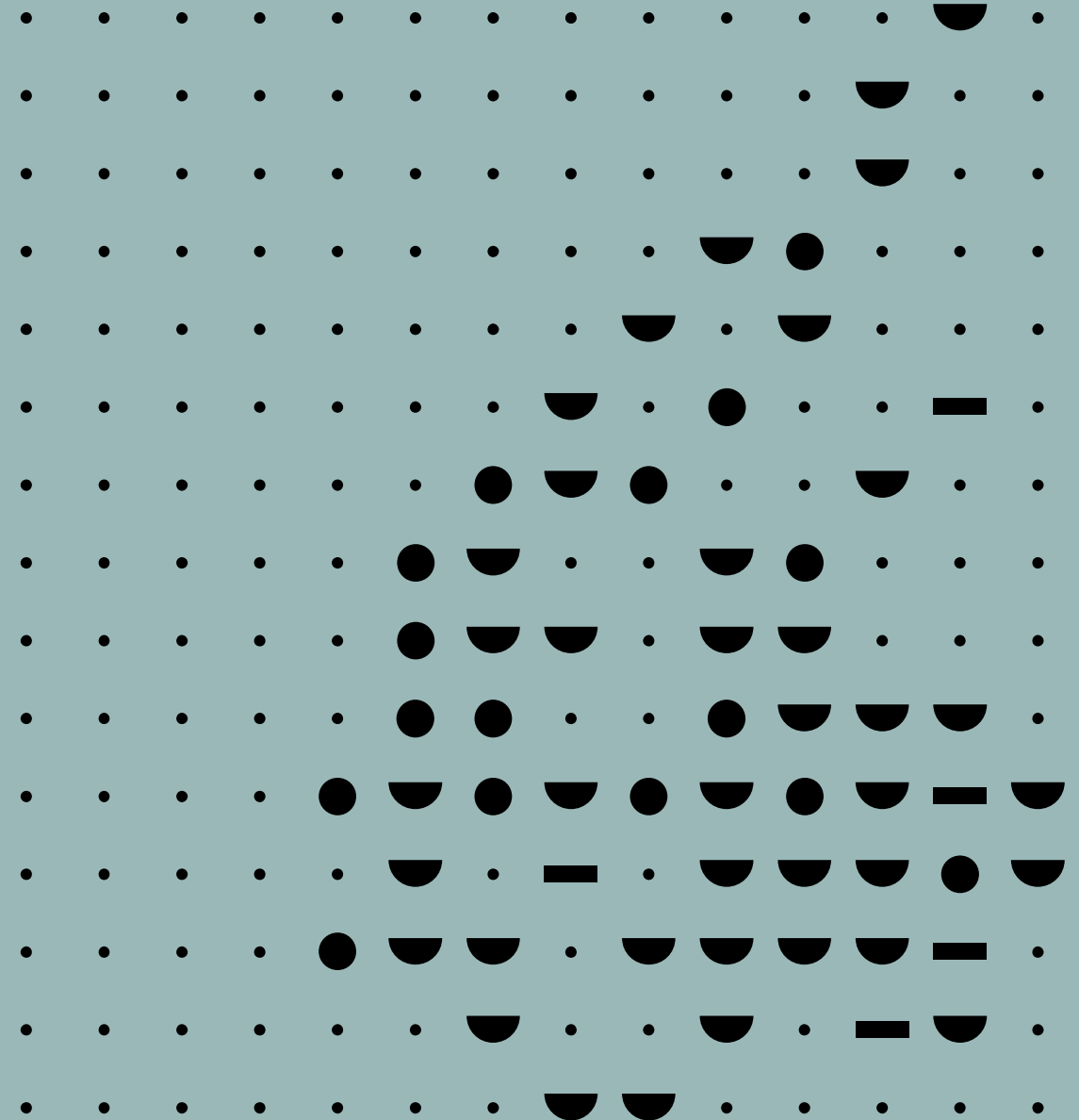

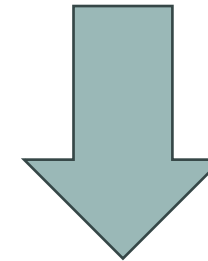


History and background

One common case management system in place and implemented in 2003 in the district and appeal courts – a prerequisite

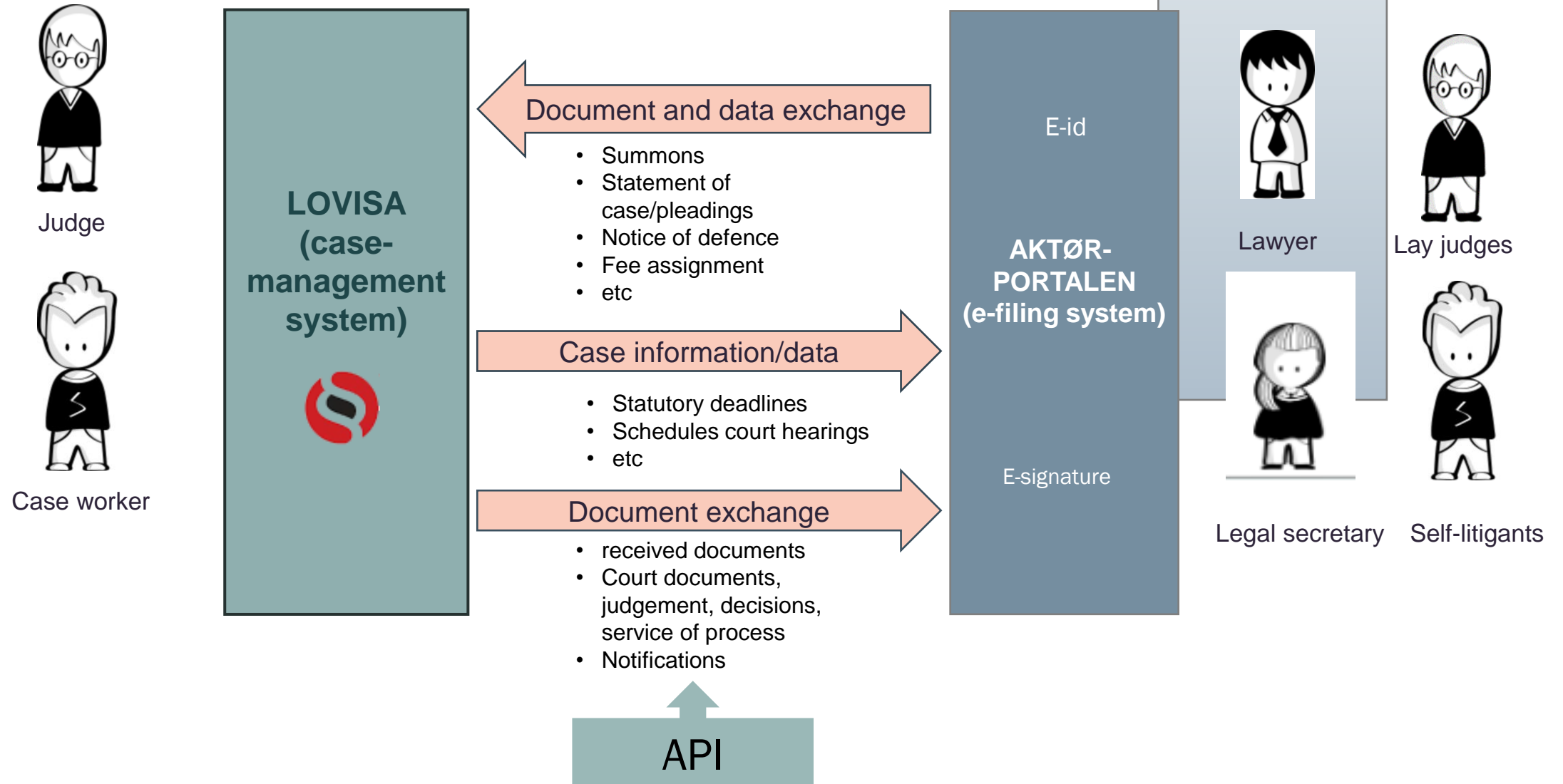
Our e-filing system developed and implementation started in 2013 – designed for ordinary civil disputes and used by only by lawyers and legal secretaries at their office.

Used by the biggest district courts and appeal court by 2017

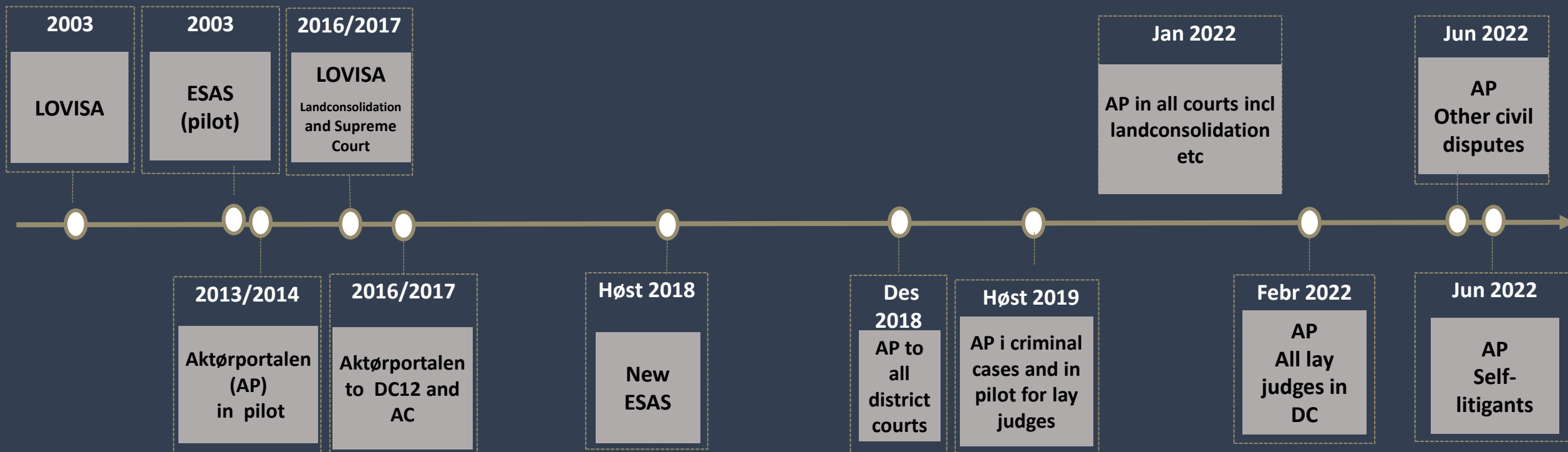


From 2018 things started to happen.....
