
### Preamble

- **EU**: directives on combating the sexual abuse and sexual exploitation of children and child pornography; and on establishing minimum standards on the rights, support and protection of victims of crime; European Commission Recommendation on developing and strengthening integrated child protection systems in the best interests of the child


