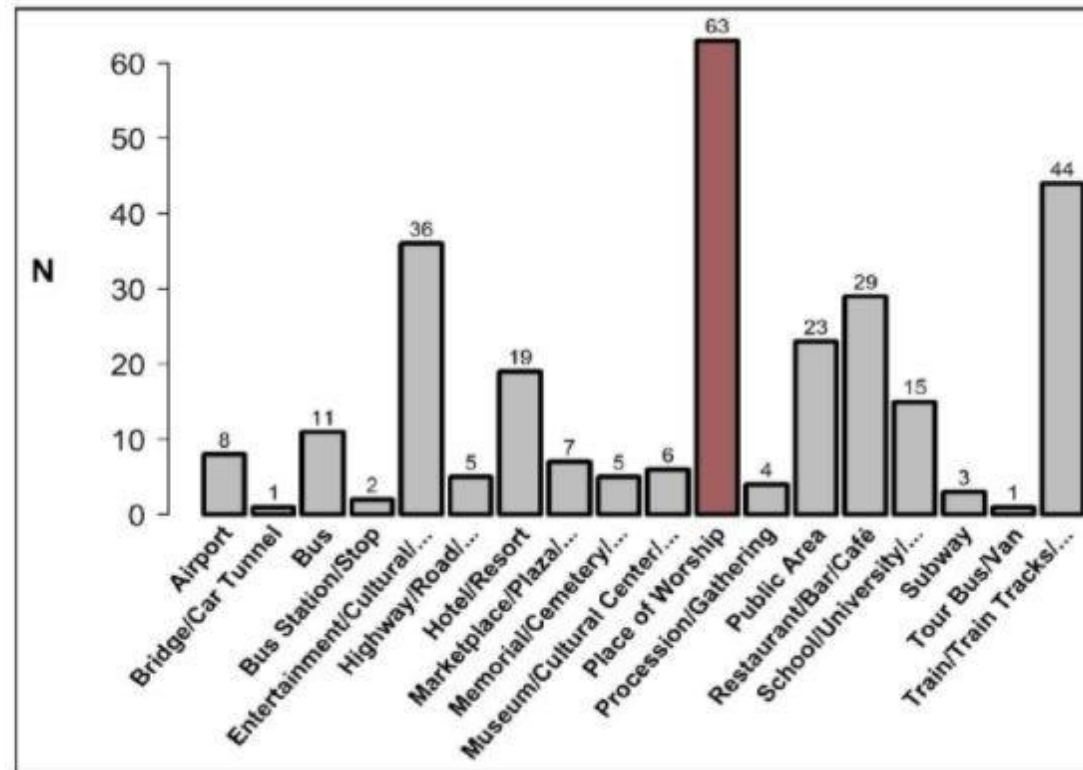


Figure 1. Number of terrorist attacks against soft targets in EU according GTD [3] data (Places of Worship GTD category is highlighted).
