Cost of Participation:

Travel and Transport to Bergen

Getting there and getting around:

The nearest airport with domestic and international flights is Bergen Airport, Flesland (BGO). It is served with international flights, to/from, inter alia, the Nordic capitals, Amsterdam, London, Paris and Frankfurt.

The airport is well connected with public transport possibilities to/from the city centre: the closest stop to the meeting venue is "Bergen Busstasjon" which is 3 minutes' walk from the hotel.

- Bergen Light Rail line 1 (Bybanen 1) (45 min. / 47 NOK): consider downloading the Skyss Ticket app.
- Airport bus (Flybussen) (30 min. / from 179 NOK)
- Taxi there are numerous taxi companies operating in Bergen. Visit Bergen recommends 07000
 Bergen Taxi, which has a set price for airport transfers to/from the city centre: 580 NOK for 1-4 persons in daytime regular weekday. Taxis can be prebooked at: +47 55 99 70 00).
