- **2.30 2.45 pm Explaining the gender mainstreaming approach:** The trainer will explain in a simple manner what gender mainstreaming is on the basis of <u>Council of Europe</u> <u>policies</u> and by giving examples.
- 2.45 3.30 pm The role of Gender Equality Rapporteurs: On the basis of the<u>"Information note</u> on gender equality rapporteurs", participants define their role and mission in more details and share their vision with the group. Four rapporteurs present theirs actions on gender equality and share good practices.

- **3.45 4.45 pm Roadmap on gender equality:** On the basis of the terms of reference or work plan of their committee/sector, Gender Equality Rapporteurs and colleagues work to define their mission and role within their committee/sector.
