

GOALS AND EXPECTED OUTCOME

he side event will examine whether and how the deliverables of interests and asset disclosures by public officials (IADPOs) correspond to the objectives set for those

systems when designed initially and ascertain what has worked best and why. Where IADPOs have proven less effective, it will seek to establish potential obstacles to more effective implementation and enforcement and share innovative ideas, concepts and solutions. The side event will give fresh momentum to the global dialogue on IADPOs by ascertaining the true functionality of IADPOs and their actual role and place in a holistic national anticorruption strategy and in the promotion of public sector integrity specifically by gauging whether IADPOs have an impact on or are at present generating potential for more forceful prevention and detection of corruption and public perception thereof.
