- Consider what factors help and hinder participation
- Cooperation and communication skills
- Take responsibility

Target audience: school youth (14-16), NGOs, youth centres (17-25), leaders of student and student self-government, 15–30 people

Activities:

- 3. Online survey among young people on the topic of democracy, participation
- 4. Event announcement

Day 2 - to organise an online "Living Library" with the involvement of IDPs who moved to communities in 2014.

Option 2

Offline in Poltava - 1 day, if there is funding from the university trade union Poltava region can be included.
