MAIN OBJECTIVES

- To improve the rights and freedom of persons deprived of liberty by reducing ill-treatment
- To ensure **effective investigation** on allegation of ill-treatment

EXPECTED OUTPUTS AND RESULTS

- 1. National preventive mechanism (NPM) staff are taking steps to improve their skills in monitoring detention facilities and to follow up on their recommendations
- 2. Kosovo* Academy of Justice is taking steps to improve trainings for the judiciary related to fight against ill treatment and torture
- 3. Kosovo* judiciary and law students are demonstrating better understanding of ECtHR standards in relation to fight against ill treatment and torture

KEY ACTIVITIES

- Development of the **NPM strategy for prevention of torture and ill-treatment for the period** 2021-2025 and a gender-sensitive monitoring guide
- Establishment of a working group to follow up on recommendations of the NPM
- Trainings on monitoring detention facilities for NPM staff
- Study visit to the CoE and the ECtHR of the NPM staff and judiciary of Kosovo*
- Development of specific module for NPM in cooperation with CPT and GRECO on how to better **monitor corruption in the prison system and report on allegation**
- Conducting **raising awareness events** on the work of the NPM with judiciary, correctional and police officers on: (a) usage of alternative measures instead of detention (b) involuntary placement in mental health facilities
- Development of training material for trainers related to prohibition of ill-treatment and caselaw of the ECtHR and conduction of training of trainers
- Cascade training activities for judges and prosecutors with ECtHR case-law
- Workshops and moot courts with students of Law faculty on the prohibition of ill-treatment
