Expected results	 Ensured that the case law databases and case management systems used by courts in Bosnia and Herzegovina apply the same methodology of case classification and, in relation to human rights issues, use the vocabulary and descriptors compatible with the approach of the European Court of Human Rights (ECtHR; Strengthened case law departments; Provided support to the work of harmonisation panels (created with the support of the Council of Europe in 2014); Fostered judicial dialogue within Bosnia and Herzegovina
