### Minutes

#### of the public hearing on “Taking into consideration the impact of the fight against the Covid-19 pandemic on the mental health of minors and young adults” held in Strasbourg on 24 January

In the framework of the report currently in preparation on “Taking into consideration the impact of the fight against the Covid-19 pandemic on the mental health of minors and young adults” by **Mr Simon Moutquin** (Belgium, SOC), the Committee **held** a public hearing with **Mx Anna Knobbout**, member of the Advisory Council on Youth (CCJ) of the Council of Europe. **Ms Selin Sayek Böke** (Türkiye, SOC), **Chairperson of the Committee**, opened the hearing, introduced the guest speaker, and gave the floor to the rapporteur for a brief introduction.

**Mr Moutquin** briefly presented the latest additions to the preliminary draft report, informed members about the results of his fact-finding visit to Oslo (Norway) and welcomed the expert. He intended to propose a change of title, so that it would correspond more to the issue that was dealt with in the report.

**Mr Davies** said that he would submit a proposal to the rapporteur concerning a proposed change of title. He was concerned that many young people were going through an existential crisis and did not want to have children. One reason for anxiety was lack of control; the impact of climate change on future generations was an example of that. The report should also consider the need to empower young people, including in the response to climate change. Many young people did not feel heard, and some joined extreme movements such as Extinction Rebellion which had been categorised as a terrorist group in the United Kingdom.

**Mr van Pareren** said that the rapporteur had tried to make this a report about climate change. Most young people were afraid about “all the hysterical news about climate change” and didn’t seem to “go with the future”. To talk about the psychological impact on young people, the rapporteur needed to consider things other than climate change and look more at psychiatry. A lot of young people were having fun, and the rapporteur should not focus on only one side of the picture.

**Mr Essl** was not able to support what the previous speakers had said, which gave the impression that the world was collapsing. The world had faced the Covid-19 pandemic and climate crisis. However, most young people he knew had a positive outlook on the future.

**Mx Knobbout** reacted to the members’ remarks. During the Covid-19 pandemic, they had lived with 20 other students, 14 of whom were waiting for mental health help and had had to wait for two years at the beginning of the pandemic just to have a first session with a psychologist. While the problems of youth and their needs were getting stronger, the waiting lists were getting longer. Many youths had suicidal thoughts. Trans youth were some of the most vulnerable and susceptible to suicide. Long waiting lists were severely impacting the mental health of youth and led to suicidal thoughts.

Prevention and including mental health as part of the school curriculum were very important. Some initiatives had been launched on this in the Netherlands. Other member States should consider launching similar initiatives. Trauma-informed schools were important, not only for refugees, but also for youth in general. Trauma was often at the root of the problem.

Although public acceptance of mental health issues had improved, mental health was still not considered on an equal footing with physical health. If someone called in sick to university and said that they had major anxiety and thus could not come to class, this would not be accepted, whereas if one called in sick due to a headache or something related to physical health, one would be encouraged to take a sick day.

**Mx Knobbout** commended the rapporteur for a good preliminary draft report and advised the rapporteur to interview some young people for the report, in order to learn more about their problems.
