

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q1: Would it be meaningful to submit a project proposal, which would reflect the current situation in the pilot country?

A1: Appendix IV of the call for proposals (Guidelines) specifies that project proposals should reflect the specific national context. For example, when deciding the issues to be addressed through the communication and advocacy campaign “CSOs are encouraged to address also other issues they might find relevant in their countries concerning the ratification/implementation of the Istanbul Convention”. Also, when specifying target groups “projects may propose to target other relevant stakeholders, while keeping in mind the general objective of the call”. Additionally, “CSOs should include in their proposals the channels of communication that would be most relevant in their country to run the communications and advocacy campaign”.
