Is that the same as the Motivation Letter or should I attach a description of attached files for instance?	08/09/2026	Bidders are responsible for deciding what information to include in their “offer message.” For example, this may comprise a general statement confirming the submission of a bid and listing the documents uploaded to the platform as part of the application file. All applications must be submitted via the e-procurement platform and should include, as attachments, all documents specified in Section “G” of the Tender File.	09/09/2026
Is a recommendation from a previous employer considered an example of work? I wrote a framework on AML for a bank, but I don’t have the documentation since its confidential. A recommendation that I wrote it from the Chief Compliance Officer can however be provided.	09/09/2026	The recommendation from a previous employer is not considered as an example of work (sample). The sample provided should enable the Council of Europe Secretariat to assess both its quality and the expert’s drafting skills.
