

Tender on the provision of trainings according to the Council of Europe manuals “Bookmarks” and “We CAN”

Questions and Answers

30 participants will be selected through an open call, we are probably talking about representatives of ethnic minorities in specific regions, aren't we? As for the other 30 participants or employees of a particular municipality, what rules and criteria do we apply to select them?

30 young participants of the training are selected through an open call by the organisation that won this tender call. The participants will be representatives of minority groups and not only, from the following regions: Kvemo Kartli, Samtskhe-Javakheti, Adjara and Pankisi. Representatives of the municipality will be selected by the project partners.

The duration of the project is 5 days. Are we talking about 5 days in total or 5 days for each stream?

The project “We together, We can”, which will consists of a training phase and a small-scale projects implementation phase, will be implemented through November 2020. Each training planned throughout the project is planned to last at least 5 days.

Should we be a registered NGO for tendering purposes?

The tenderer of this call must be a legal person except consortia. The eligibility criteria defined in this call is the following:

- Be a registered organization in Georgia with 2 years of experience in the field of human rights education and/or education on equality and anti-discrimination including, but not limited to, trainings using the manuals “Compass” and/or “Bookmarks” and/or “We CAN”;
- 2 years of experience in managing small-scale projects and/or funds received from international organisations;

The eligibility criteria doesn't specify that the tenderer must be a registered NGO.
