

<p>Which language should I use to fill out the application form and budget – Ukrainian or English? Do I need to translate partnership letters and CVs into English?</p>	<p>Documents should be filled out in English (as indicated in the Call for Proposals document), as well as partnership letters and CVs. Ukrainian language can be used for registration documents, a copy of the statute, and financial report for 2023.</p> <p>It is expected that all reporting for the grant project will also be submitted in English, so please include translation services in the budget if needed.</p>
<p>Is the 2 years of experience a strict criterion to participate in the grant awards? Can we apply with our current 1.5 years of experience and provide a detailed description of the project proposal?</p>	<p>Yes, the requirement for 2 years of experience is strict. This is the minimum experience for an applicant to be eligible to apply for Council of Europe grants.</p>
<p>We added an additional column to display the funding from the Council of Europe since we couldn't capture the essence of the percentages in the table. Is this budget format acceptable?</p>	<p>Please carefully read the requirements for filling out the budget table (attached in the grant announcement). You don't need to detail how much funding the organisation will provide—just provide the total amount in the table header. Also, you cannot indicate an amount you expect from the Council of Europe that exceeds the proposed amount—in this case, 10,000 euros.</p>
<p>Our organisation's financial report for the year 2023 is not yet available. Can we provide the financial report for the year 2022 or any other documents that can confirm the income and expenses of our organisation instead?</p>	<p>Yes, in this case, you can submit the financial report for the year 2022.</p>
<p>What are the eligibility criteria for grant selection? Can applications be submitted by organizations registered in the USA or EU countries?</p>	<p>All criteria are described in the Call for Proposals document. It is expected that grants under the project will be awarded to Ukrainian civil society organisations.</p>
<p>What scale of activity would you like to see from participants? Should the proposed activities cover the entire country or a specific region sufficient? Can we focus on working with a group of several specific target communities?</p>	<p>Yes, the project can cover either a region or specific community/communities.</p>
<p>Can you check the documents before the deadline and provide your recommendations and edits?</p>	<p>No, the evaluation committee does not have the right to open the documents before the application deadline expires.</p>
<p>Is it possible to prepare the budget in hryvnias?</p>	<p>No, the budget, as well as the final report, should be in euros.</p>
<p>We couldn't find Annex III mentioned in the guidelines for completing the budget tables in the announcement.</p>	<p>Annex III is the financial report for the project. This table will be provided to the grantees upon receiving the grant.</p>

<p>Should we include letters of support from local government bodies during the project application submission, if the project activities involve collaboration with local self-government bodies?</p>	<p>Yes, you can include letters of support from local self-government bodies, but it's not a mandatory requirement.</p>
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
