

Tenders for the provision of local consultancy services in the area of access to justice and violence against women in Eastern Partnership countries

Questions and answers

Q1: Is the applicant required to reside/have the citizenship of the countries included in the call?

A: No, none of the eligibility and/or award criteria refer to country of residence and/or citizenship of the applicants. Please read and fill the required documentation carefully.

Q2: Is the consultancy only online?

A: No, the consultants are required to travel and deliver outputs in person in the countries included in the call.

Q3: Can police officers apply to this call?

A: Yes, they can apply. They will have to comply with the eligibility requirements provided in the call documentation.

Q4: What level of language fluency is required for this consultancy?

A: Fluency of English is required. Fluency of English corresponds to a minimum C1 level (Proficient user)

Q5: Will the structure and contents of the training courses determined by the Council of Europe or the consultant?

A: Details of the particular tasks will be determined after selection of national experts.

Q6: Can you apply for more than one call for experts with the Council of Europe? Do I qualify for this consultancy if I am already on a Council of Europe roster of experts?

A: Yes, you can apply for more than one call for experts with the Council of Europe. Yes, you qualify for this consultancy.

Q7: Is lack of fluency in English a disqualifying criterion in all cases?

A: Yes, fluency of English (minimum C1 level -proficient user) is an eligibility criteria under this call.
