**Rapport de la  
3<sup>ème</sup> Réunion plénière de rédaction  
du Protocole du T-CY  
(Strasbourg 28 – 29 novembre 2018)**

La 3ème réunion plénière de rédaction du Protocole du T-CY (ci-après : " PDP ") s'est tenue au Conseil de l'Europe à Strasbourg du 28 au 29 novembre 2018. Elle a été présidée par la présidente, Cristina Schulman (Roumanie).

Y ont participé 150 représentants des 61 Parties ainsi que des états observateurs de même que des organisations internationales et des Comités du Conseil de l'Europe.

Le PDP a été précédé par la 20<sup>ème</sup> session plénière du T-CY le 27 novembre ainsi que des consultations du groupe de rédaction du protocole avec les experts de la protection des données le 26 novembre.

La session plénière du PDP,

- a pris note de l'état actuel de la proposition de règlement et de directive de l'UE sur les preuves électroniques et confirmé la nécessité d'assurer la cohérence entre ces textes et le deuxième Protocole additionnel à la Convention de Budapest ;
- a adopté provisoirement le texte et le rapport explicatif sur la "vidéo conférence" ;
- est convenu de rendre public le projet de disposition sur la "vidéo conférence" pour observations à soumettre avant le 20 février 2019, étant entendu qu'il s'agit d'une version préliminaire qui pourrait, à mesure que le protocole évoluera, changer considérablement ;
- est convenu de partager les projets de dispositions sur les "langues dans lesquelles doit être formulée une demande", "l'enraide judiciaire d'urgence" et la "vidéoconférence" avec le PC-OC (Comité d'experts sur le fonctionnement des conventions européennes sur la coopération en matière pénale) pour commentaires avant le 20 février 2019 ;
- a échangé des points de vues sur :
  - "la juridiction";
  - "le modèle d'approbation";
  - "la coopération directe avec les fournisseurs de services " et " les injonctions de produire internationales ";
  - " l'extension des recherches/accès sur la base des pouvoirs";
  - "enquêtes conjointes et équipes conjointes d'enquête";
  - "techniques d'enquête";
- a convenu de tenir les prochaines consultations avec l'industrie, les institutions liés à la protection des données et/ou les organisations de la société civile d'ici mai 2019, et d'encourager les Parties à engager des consultations avec les parties prenantes au niveau national sur les projets de dispositions publics et les concepts d'autres dispositions le cas échéant ;
- a accepté de rendre public un rapport sommaire de ce PDP.
