Rendez-vous aux jardins by Ministry of Culture



Designed on the model of "Journées du patrimoine", the "Rendez-vous aux jardins" is organized on the first weekend of June since 2003. This event brings together more than 2 300 parks and gardens that open their doors to public, for some exceptionnally, and which offer various animations. This theme has been changing every year since 2005.

In 2017, 3 500 events are organized in 2 300 gardens.






The objective of *Rendez-vous aux* jardins is to introduce to a large public parks and gardens that are historical, contemporary, urban or rural all over France.

This event also adresses issues related to biodiversity, sustainable development and plant genetic ressources.

A specific day (Friday) is devoted to the school public.





Fridays offer a special appointment for children, especially schoolchildren. Workshops and meetings between gardeners and young people are always particularly interesting and appreciated.

The owners are invited to contact the schools located near their garden early enough and to reflect with the teachers to set up activities.



The Rendez-vous aux jardins also highlights the activities carried out by the Ministry of Culture in favor of parks and gardens as well as those of public and private owners.

Media partners (press, television, radio) or partnership of competence support the event.





Conditions of participation

To participate for the first time to the *Rendez-vous aux jardins* you must contact the organisers of this event in each region

Opening conditions:

The garden must have a historical or contemporary interest, aesthetic, architectural, landscaping, botanical ...

The garden must be well maintained

The reception of the public must be planned

Reduced price and free admitance for young public are recommanded.

If you have already participated, you can register again your garden on « Open agenda » every year.

Posters of different formats 120x176 cm, 40x60 cm et 29,7x42 cm

This event would not exist without the support of the 225 territorial collectivities which, without remuneration, relay the operation on their poster space.

In total, 1000 posters (120x176) and nearly 4500 (40x60 et 29,7x42) are affixed by the participative municipalities.

Some regions do not offer a leaflet but an updated website.










