  bodies of the Council of Europe)
- Carry out Webinar projects already well underway with others:
  - + The Interreligious / Interfaith Committee
  - + Children's Rights Committee
  - + the Education to Democracy Committee
- Ensure the monitoring on migration regarding current events in Europe or Member INGOs
- Anticipate the end of the mandate of the Committee "Rights of Migrants" by
  designing and proposing ways to make the concerns of the Conference of INGOs in
  the field of migration and human rights sustainable.

At its meeting on 2023 March, 8th and 9th, the Committee decided to **keep the same** Chair, Mr. Daniel Guéry.

The idea of a female and male co-chair was raised for all Committees in the coming legislatures as well as encouragement for the creation of "internal" working groups delegated to one of the members of the committee.

3. In which committees and other Council of Europe activities is this committee mainly involved? See attached list.

The Committee on the Rights of Migrants has regular contacts with the "Permanent Commission" of the Conference of INGOs, its President and Géneviève Laloy, its representative for the Committee.

3.1 Since its creation, its validation by the General Assembly on April 2021, the Committee on the Rights of Migrant Persons has contacted the **Special Representation of the Secretary General of the Council of Europe on Migration, Refugees and Asylum Seekers.** 

In concrete terms, this means:

- ✓ An initial contact with presentation of the objectives,
- ✓ A comparative presentation between the "Council of Europe Action Plan" and the Committee's
  Action Plan "Rights of Migrant Persons"; the identification of commonalities with the aim of
  working collaboratively,
- ✓ Participation in coordination meetings between the various departments and services of the Council of Europe (quarterly meetings) in order to inform each other and enrich specific approaches and actions.
  - At the last meeting, the Committee was able to express its views on the question of the "mental health" of migrants in relation to the situations they are likely to experience.
- ✓ A special meeting was organised to present the Committee's visit-mission to Greece with a comparative analysis between the Council of Europe Action Plan for Migrants, the project of the Migration Committee of the Conference of INGOs and the conclusions of the visit to Greece. Several points were retained by the SRSG such as the major importance of access to safe accommodation that respects the dignity of each person, the importance of pooling local, regional and national skills, etc.
- 3.2 The issues dealt with by the Committee on the Rights of Migrants are naturally linked to other Committees created in April 2021 or at the last General Assembly of the Conference of INGOs of the Council of Europe. Indeed, the Committee is particularly committed to address the holistic dimension of migration and not just one aspect. At least one representative of the following Committees are thus present as a "structural link":
  - √ The Committee of "Civil Society for the Rights of the Child"
  - √ The Committee "Action for Social Rights"
  - ✓ The Interreligious and Interfaith Committee
  - √ The Committee: "Education for Democracy"

Concretely, this means that the drafting of the foundation texts on the right to health, safety and education have been carried out taking into account the reflections of the other Committees, but above all that we are committed to specific "inter-committee" activities such as ad hoc webinars (see table of activities of the report).
