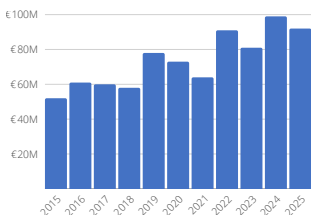

From 2015 to 2025, voluntary contributions have **increased by 76%**.



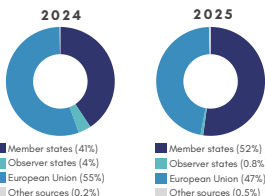

The **European Union** remained our largest donor in 2025 while **Germany** was the largest bilateral donor. **42** of the **46 member states** contributed in 2025.

SPOTLIGHT 2025

Germany was the top bilateral donor in 2025 with a contribution of over €14 million. As the **lead donor to the Council of Europe Action Plan for Ukraine 2023-2026 (€9.97 million)**, Germany plays a key role in supporting Ukraine's reform agenda and its path to a European future. Germany is a strong supporter of the **Convention system**, ranking among the largest donors to both the European Court of Human Rights and the implementation of its judgments. Germany is also a member of the **Human Rights Trust Fund (HRTF)**.
