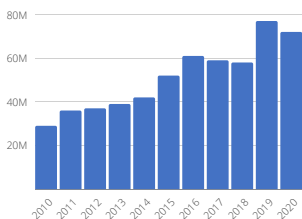


RESOURCE MOBILISATION AT A GLANCE

From 2010 to 2020, voluntary contributions more than **doubled**.



FUNDING SOURCES

The **European Union** remained our **largest donor** in 2020 while **Norway** remained our largest bilateral donor. Collectively, **observer States** doubled their contribution as compared to 2019.

The Action Plan aims to accompany the country in its efforts to bring legislation, institutions and practice further in line with European standards.

STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS

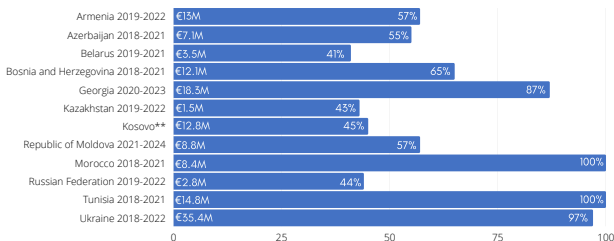
