

## Resources on the Roma Genocide in Latvia

### ➤ Educational material

Text books, teaching materials and methodological materials for teachers are developed in accordance with the national curriculum and, therefore, also address the Holocaust and anti-Semitism. Several books on the Holocaust and the history of the Jewish community in Latvia are presently available for use by students, including [Tell Ye Your Children: a book about the Holocaust in Europe 1933-1945](#), by Paul A. Levine and Stephane Bruchfeld. Numerous materials for teachers have also been prepared, such as *A Controversial History*, a handbook published by the Latvian Association of History Teachers (LAHT).
