Questions received	Answers
<p>1. Is it necessary to have two licensed/certified i2 trainers for (2) 3-day i2 Analyst's Notebook training classes with (10) students in each class? We teach these classes each week with up to 12 students in a class and only use one i2 instructor.</p> <p>2. The bid says to provide "training facilities, including premises, equipment and licenses for the delivery of the basic and advanced training". Can we use your facility for the i2 training? We can ship laptop computers with the latest i2 Analyst's Notebook software to your facility. Do you have a data projector and internet access for the class?</p> <p>3. We have datasets that we can use for the training in English. Do you want the data to be translated into Ukrainian?</p> <p>4. We have the best i2 instructors in the industry but they speak English. Do you have access to English/Ukrainian translators? We would need two translators. One translating for the i2 instructor and one who will roam around the room helping the students.</p> <p>5. Do you need the i2 Analyst's Notebook student manuals translated to Ukrainian? We can do that but there is a cost associated with that.</p> <p>6. Can you provide ground transportation for the i2 instructors; from the hotel to the training facility and return to the hotel?</p> <p>7. What type electrical adapters in Ukraine is required, i.e. types C and F?</p>	<p>1. – 5. Please kindly refer to Section A of the Act of Engagement, which requires trainings to be delivered by at least two licensed/certified trainers in Ukrainian. According to the specifications detailed in the Act of Engagement, the trainings are to be delivered using facilities, equipment, licenses and training materials, including data sets of the Service Provider.</p> <p>6. Ground transportation is not envisaged within the scope of the current tender.</p> <p>7. Both types C and F of electrical adapters are used in Ukraine.</p>
