Tourism sustainability plan for Onís in the Picos de Europa national park Action lines










Onís is a municipality in the Picos de Europa National Park. Municipality adjacent to Cangas de Onís (6.316 inhabitants, main entrance to the national park (1.7 million visits, one of the most visited national parks in Spain).

The municipality of Onís has only 732 inhabitants.








SUSTAINABILITY AND DIGITALISATION OF THE NETWORK OF ECOTOURISM EXPERIENCES IN SPAIN








Experience Scientific Ecotourism in Spain: take part in Spain's biodiversity conservation success stories






