AUDIT OPINION

We have examined the Budgetary Management Accounts of the Council of Europe for the year ended 31 December 2021, which comprise a Statement of Expenditure and Receipts for each Budget and Subsidiary Budget of the Council of Europe, and for the Partial Agreements and Special Accounts, and related supporting notes.

The Secretary General of the Council of Europe is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the Budgetary Management Accounts in accordance with Articles 61 and 63 of the Financial Regulations of the Council of Europe and for implementing adequate internal control to ensure the preparation of Budgetary Management Accounts that are free from material misstatements, whether due to fraud or error.

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these Budgetary Management Accounts on the basis of our audit, in accordance with Article 72 of the Financial Regulations of the Council of Europe. We have conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing and Article 71 of the Financial Regulations of the Council of Europe. Our work was planned and performed so as to obtain reasonable assurance that the Budgetary Management Accounts are free from material misstatement. We have examined, on a test basis, the amounts and other disclosures in the Budgetary Management Accounts. We have also examined the accounting principles applied and the presentation of the Budgetary Management Accounts. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

It is our opinion that the Budgetary Management Accounts properly reflect the financial records and transactions of the Council of Europe for the year ended 31 December 2021 and that they have been prepared in compliance with the Financial Regulations.

In accordance with Articles 71 and 72 of the Financial Regulations, we have also prepared a report to the Committee of Ministers setting out our observations on the Budgetary Management Accounts of the Council of Europe.

Decides:
