## SUMMARY

Exchange between afro-swedish youth groups and already existing Diaspora-related networks (e.g. ADYNE in Portugal). The exchange allowed youth to share outcomes reached on youth Diaspora inclusion and to propose possiblr collaborationd on new projects.

Participation to the World Social Forum in Dakar for setting-up of a common space for North-South Youth dialogue and cooperation including African Diaspora in Europe and capacity building activities in order to empower the role of youth leaders of the future.

The strategic steering group meeting aimed to develop mechanisms for a better awareness of Africa Diaspora youth organisations on how become more active in the Africa-EU political process.

The projects point at strengthening the role of media (such as radio) to reach more Youth African Diaspora in order to increase the awarenes on HIV/AIDS prevention strategies.

First ADYNE training course for African Youth Diaspora in Switzerland in order to promote the participation of African Youth Diaspora in the development of European and African youth policies.

Seminar planned and implemented by a group of young students from Norway, Ethiopia and Eritrea with the aim of enhancing dialogue and conflict resolution between Ethiopian and Eritrean youth Diaspora both living in Africa and in Europe.

Training course on strategies for mapping and researching African youth organisations and a focus on young leaders and their contributions for the development of civic rights.

The Seminar gathered youth activists from across Europe to discuss the importance the media can play in the process of inclusion of Africa diaspora youth, citizenship and youth empowerment.

The training course has been attended by 37 young people between youth of African origin living in Slovenia and Slovenians working with or interested to work with the African Diaspora, exchanging experiences snd encouraged in helping to map the challenges faced by the participants.

The training brought together 32 university students and 10 youth leaders from the Portuguese Speaking African Countries (PALOP) who are active in youth organisations, creating a channel of communication between young people and youth organisations.

Training course focused on intercultural dialogue, conflict prevention and communication. The training empowered the African youth living in Spain and their organizations in order to make them full part of local development.
