ISON is an international law enforcement network dedicated to combatting migrant smuggling, comprised of experts from source, transit and destination countries

- → To increase data sharing among concerned member countries and concerned units.
- → To foster operational collaboration in the international fight against migrant smuggling.
- \rightarrow To promote the publication of INTERPOL notices and diffusions.
- → To become a perdurable platform regarded as the Point of Contact by external partners in future projects

INTERPOL POLICING CAPABILITIES

Unique reliable means to identify, locate and apprehend traffickers and smugglers and disrupt transnational criminal networks.

INTERPOL's extensive set of global databases, covering a range of identification means, as well as its system of notices are of real added-value for law enforcement worldwide when it comes to combatting TIP and SOM.

Example: the fraudulent use of identity documents to enable illegal entry is common practice for migrant smugglers, as such the SLTD database is particularly important to detect potential cases of smuggling.
