



TRAINING SESSION ON SOCIAL RIGHTS

Thursday, 28 June from 14.30 to 16.30 AGORA room G01 (English speaking group)

This training session is organised by the Conference of INGOs of the Council of Europe during its Summer session and with the support of the Secretariat of the European Social Charter.

We will try to better understand the monitoring system of the social rights listed in this treaty which has been signed by 43 European States, and to think about the possible role of NGOs in the effective implementation of these rights.
